BY THE WAY . . .

- It's here! Saint Anthony's **41st Annual Saint Anthony's Feast** begins on Wednesday, June 14, and continues through Saturday, June 17. Come and enjoy the fellowship, food, rides, games, zeppole and fun of a grand parish community get together. And . . . if you are able to volunteer at some point over the four nights, please consider doing so.

- Tuesday, June 13 is the **Solemnity of Saint Anthony of Padua**, the 13th century Portuguese Franciscan priest and doctor of the Church, who is our parish patron. Come to the last of the nine-Tuesdays Novena on Tuesday night at 7:30 P.M., including the veneration of the relic of Saint Anthony, and help give honor to Almighty God and to the great saint who is our parish patron.

- **Conventual changes** – the Salesian Sisters have recently announced transfers affecting the various schools and ministries of their religious community. A few of them affect us here at Saint Anthony's.

Sister Marisol Guzman, F.M.A. who has been teaching in Saint Anthony's School for the past several years has been transferred for one year to Monterrey, Mexico where she will be on the front line of the immigration crisis, working with migrants coming to the United States to help prepare them for the transition.

Sister Theresa Lee, F.M.A., who has been living in our convent while serving as Chancellor and Delegate for Religious of the Paterson Diocese, will be relocating to the Motherhouse in Haledon to help better facilitate her transportation needs.

No stranger to us, Sister Maria Colombo, F.M.A., the provincial Secretary, will be returning to Saint Anthony's as the Animator (superior) of the Convent.

And finally, we welcome to Saint Anthony's Sister Lillian Foxx, F.M.A., a Chicago native and experienced educator, who will be transferring to Saint Anthony's School from the Salesian High School in Harvey, Louisiana.

- The Paterson Diocese is sponsoring a one-day **Quo Vadis Retreat** on Thursday, June 29, beginning at 9:00 A.M. at Camp Shiloh, 753 Burnt Meadow Road, Hewitt, N.J. "Quo vadis" means "where are you going" and is a retreat for young men of high school age encouraging them in their vocational path of life. The experience offered free by the Diocesan Vocation Office will include three meals, zip-lining, swimming, rock climbing, archery, games, sports and Holy Mass with Bishop Sweeney. - Today marks the 57th anniversary of the death of **Monsignor Joseph M. O'Sullivan, P.A.** (1894-1966), Saint Anthony's third pastor. Monsignor O'Sullivan's fourteen years as pastor (1952-1966) were marked by the constructions of the new addition to the school as well as the rectory.

- Pray this week to our heavenly patron for good weather and a successful feast in his honor.

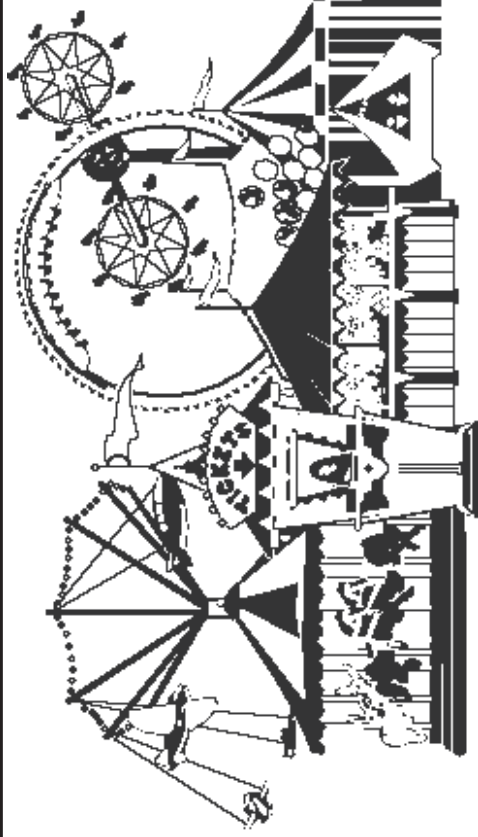

Changes Discounted Ride Tickets for The Feast:

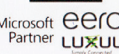
