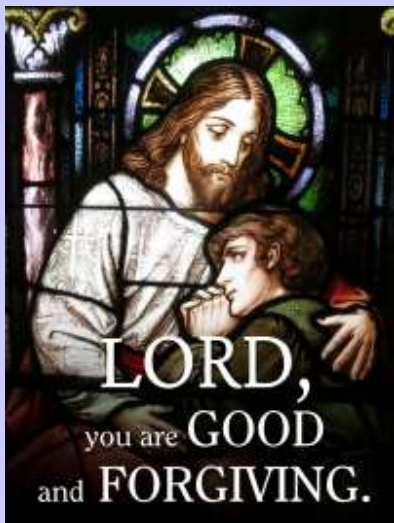

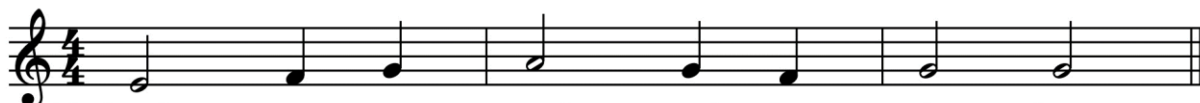

BY THE WAY . . .

- One of the summer projects you may have noticed taking place around our campus is the refurbishment of the **Jubilee Garden** between the rectory and the school. Originally constructed fifteen years ago during Monsignor Hundt's time at Saint Anthony's, the Jubilee Garden commemorates the parish's 100th anniversary and has become a popular place for prayer and reflection, photos for weddings and First Communions, and memorializing beloved loved ones by means of the paver stones around the garden. During the height of the Covid 19 pandemic Father Sylwester and I actually heard Confessions on Saturday afternoons in the Jubilee Garden!

As with any outdoor installation, the past fifteen years have taken their toll on the Jubilee Garden, especially on the pergola which sets it off. But a number of forces have come together to give the Garden much more than just a facelift. Glenn Veprek, a Scout from Troop 31 in Ramsey was looking for an Eagle Scout project. His employer, Joe Silvestri, at Goffle Road Poultry Farm suggested he look at our Jubilee Garden. Meanwhile Saint Anthony's Knights of Columbus had also looked at the statue of Saint Anthony which is the centerpiece of the Garden and decided it was in sad shape and needed to be replaced. Under the expert direction of Victor Tamburro, and with the willing expertise of Kenny O'Boyle who first helped construct the pergola, and Dave Palmer, Glenn and the scouts of Troop 31 have rebuilt the pergola, cleaned and repainted the benches and rebuilt the pedestal which will provide the base for a new composite marble statue of Saint Anthony donated by the Knights of Columbus. It was not exactly light work, but many hands did make it all come together.

Thank you to the Knights, Glenn and the Scouts, and Victor, Ken and Joe who have helped make this project a reality. Thanks also to Dennis and Robyn Spyckaboer and to Maggie Matro of Waldwick Gardens who keep the garden looking fresh, clean and mulched.

Save the Date: Bishop Kevin Sweeney will come to Saint Anthony's on Sunday, September 24 to celebrate the 10:00 A.M. Mass and to bless the new statue of Saint Anthony and the refurbished Jubilee Garden.

- **Eucharistic Adoration** – During this coming year the Catholic Church throughout the United States will be celebrating a Eucharistic Revival, to help us all reaffirm our belief in and love for Our Lord present in the Eucharist. As part of that effort, we will resume our series of monthly Eucharistic Holy Hours. Most of these will be held on the First Fridays of each month at 7:30 in the church. The dates for the coming year are as follows:

September 8	February 3
October 6	March 1
November 3	April 7 (Divine Mercy Sunday at 3:00 P.M.)
December 1	May 3
January 5	June 7

Each of these hours will include Exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, the prayerful recitation of the Rosary, Scripture, and silent time for quiet prayer and reflection. Please set these times aside on your calendar now and plan on spending some refreshing time with Our Lord.

SOLES4SOULS SNEAKERS & SHOES DRIVE

Continuing through July 30, in partnership with the Soles4Souls organization, a non-profit headquartered in Tennessee (with a facility in NJ), we're hosting a shoe drive. You may donate **gently used** and/or new shoes and sneakers, men's, women's, and children's sizes (all items with eyelets must have laces). When people experience an economic hardship, either chronically or because of an emergency, meeting basic needs is of course a challenge. Soles4Souls gets new footwear to people in crisis, enabling them to free up financial resources they can use toward other needs.

Gently used shoes/sneakers are funneled to developing countries, where people start small businesses to sell them, thus earning money to provide for their families--and people who need footwear the most get them at a price they can afford. The program serves as long-term opportunities to break the cycle of poverty for those in need.

FOOD PANTRY NEEDS

"Summertime, and the 'livin' is easy." That's what the song lyrics say. But for those struggling to put food on their table, the reality is otherwise, especially with children being unable to have the benefit of school lunches during the summer. Grocery prices continue to accelerate, and people continue to pay top dollar to feed their families. We're again asking for your help in keeping our pantry stocked. We can use white rice (small boxes/packages), pancake mix & lite syrup, canned tuna in water, canned chicken, canned stew, small canned hams (available at Walgreens), baked beans/pork and beans, pasta & pasta sauce, mayonnaise, Chef Boyardee products, Hamburger Helper, Suddenly Salad, peanut butter & jelly, low-sodium soups, chicken broth, coffee (including decaf), canned fruit in 100% fruit juice, canned olives, applesauce, instant mashed potatoes & low-sodium gravy packets, Parmalat or similar shelf stable milk, fruit juice, cookies & crackers, granola bars, Jell-O & pudding mixes, cake, cookies & brownie mixes and icing, laundry detergent, toilet tissue, facial tissue, paper towels, and paper plates. Donations may be left in the baskets on the right in the front (main) vestibule. ShopRite gift cards are also welcome, and if you'd like to write a check, please make it payable to St. Anthony's, with "food pantry" on the memo line. Checks in a sealed envelope marked "Social Services" can be put in the collection basket or mailed to or dropped off at the rectory. While we're grateful for all food donations, ***we can't distribute expired items, so please make sure to check the expiration dates on all items you're considering donating.*** Again, we thank you for your thoughtfulness and generosity. Our Ministry couldn't do all that it does without your continued support.
