

BY THE WAY . . .

- As part of the parish's centennial celebration in 2008, Monsignor George Hundt led the parish in developing the space between the rectory and the school as a **Jubilee Prayer Garden**. Set off by a statue of Saint Anthony, a pergola and several benches the garden was originally conceived as a quiet place of prayer and meditation on an otherwise busy campus. It was dedicated by Monsignor Hundt fifteen years ago. The garden has taken on a life of its own. It has become not only a place for prayer and meditation, but also for photos, and for commemorating our deceased loved ones by means of the Paver Program which allows parishioners to remember loved ones with an engraved paver stone around the garden. During the summer of Covid, Father Sylwester and I heard Saturday Confessions in the Garden, and the Rosary Society used it as a place to pray the Rosary when the church was closed.

Time and weather have not been kind to the various components of the Jubilee Garden. However, a number of different groups and individuals have come forward to help refurbish the space. As his Eagle Scout project, Glenn Veprek has led a team refurbishing the benches and pergola, the Knights of Columbus have generously donated a new marble composite statue of Saint Anthony, Victor Tamburro has worked on resetting some of the pavers, and Robin and Dennis Spyckaboer have been working on maintaining the garden.

On Sunday, September 24, Bishop Kevin Sweeney will come to visit the parish and celebrate the 10:00 A.M. Mass. Following Mass we will process over to the Garden and Bishop will bless the new statue and refurbishment. I invite everyone to join the Bishop that day, especially those whose loved ones are commemorated in the Garden.

- The opening of school also signals the opening of **Religious Education**. Sunday, September 17 is **Catechetical Sunday** the days when our teachers and students in Religious Education are blessed for the coming year. We are still in need of a number of teachers and aides, both for the Sunday and Monday programs, in Grades 2-6. If you can assist in passing on the faith to our young people, please contact Sister Betty Ann, F.M.A. at the Religious Ed. Office.

- This Friday, September 8, the Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary will mark our first **Eucharistic Adoration** in the church from 7:30 to 8:30 P.M. Why not come and wish a Happy Birthday to the Blessed Virgin Mary by spending some time in adoration with her Son.

- **Ministry Renewal** – shortly after Labor Day, we will be looking to augment our three liturgical ministries, namely lectors, Communion ministers, and altar servers. Training will be provided in all three categories. Please take the time to consider if you are able to help out with one of these three areas. For more information, please speak to Father Ray or Father Frank, or watch the bulletin for more information.

- On Saturday, October 14, the Paterson Diocese will sponsor a **one-day pilgrimage** to the National Shrine. This pilgrimage will give the opportunity for us to gather in prayer, and in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary, gathered around Bishop Sweeney in the Great Upper Church of the Basilica, the largest Catholic church in the nation. The Sacrament of Penance as well as the

Rosary will be available that day. And, of course, on that day we can all wave at Saint Anthony as he looks down on us.

Those interested in an overnight option should contact Father Michael Rodak at 973 -827-8030. Those interested in the one-day pilgrimage should sign up at the rectory.

- Sunday, September 17 at 3:30 P.M. we will have **Confirmation Practice** in the church for all those receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation from Bishop Sweeney the next evening, Monday, September 18, as well as their sponsors.
- Friday of this week is the **Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary**.

FOOD PANTRY UPDATE

Summer may be just about over but those in need of food continue to come to our parish pantry for assistance, and our Ministry is doing its best to meet increasing demand. We again appeal to you for your help. Your support is critical to the work of our Ministry and is greatly appreciated. We can use white rice (small boxes/packages), pancake mix & lite syrup, canned tuna in water, canned chicken, canned stew, small canned hams (available at Walgreens), baked beans/pork and beans, pasta & pasta sauce, mayonnaise, Chef Boyardee products (both canned items and microwaveable cups), Hamburger Helper, Suddenly Salad, peanut butter & jelly, low-sodium soups, chicken and beef broth, coffee (including decaf), canned fruit in 100% fruit juice, canned olives, applesauce, instant mashed potatoes & low-sodium gravy packets, Parmalat or similar shelf stable milk, hot chocolate mixes, fruit juice, cookies & crackers, granola bars, Jell-O & pudding mixes, cake, cookie & brownie mixes and icing, laundry and dish detergent, toilet tissue, facial tissue, paper towels, paper plates, and personal hygiene items (toothpaste, toothbrushes, deodorant, body wash and shampoo for men & women, etc.). Donations may be left in the baskets on the right in the front (main) vestibule.

ShopRite gift cards are also welcome, and if you'd like to write a check, please make it payable to St. Anthony's, with "food pantry" on the memo line. Checks in a sealed envelope marked "Social Services" can be put in the collection basket or mailed to or dropped off at the rectory. While we're grateful for all food donations, we can't distribute expired items, so please make sure to check the expiration dates on all items you're considering donating. Again, we thank you for your thoughtfulness and generosity. Our Ministry couldn't do all that it does without your continued support.

ATTENTION SENIORS!

Passaic County Dept. of Senior Services provides one hot meal Monday through Friday at the Hawthorne Senior Center (Ambulance Corps Building), 970 Goffle Rd. There is a minimal fee, and it's a friendly environment conducive to socialization. The Center also conducts various activities such as parties, trips, lectures, etc. that meet the needs of participants. The Center is open from 8:30 A.M. to 1:30 P.M. For further information, call 973 423 1027 or the County Nutrition Office at 973 569 4060.

And if you need transportation: The Passaic County Paratransit Program maintains a fleet of vehicles, which provide transportation for the county's senior citizens age 60 and over and disabled residents in need of non-emergency rides to medical appointments, shopping centers, county-run nutrition and adult day care sites, and for disabled residents to attend group work programs. Special lift vans are available to accommodate nonambulatory individuals; service animals and portable oxygen will be accommodated. There is no fee for this service, however a donation of \$2.00 per trip is suggested. All donations are used to support Paratransit.
