- Each year the Paterson Diocese celebrates the **Vivere Christus Awards** given by Bishop Sweeney to one individual or couple from each parish in the diocese in recognition of their service to the local Church. I am happy to announce that the recipient this year from Saint Anthony's is **Michael Pasquale**. Mike helps the parish in a lot of behind-the-scenes ways as our



parish attorney. But, even more than that, Mike has served for a quarter-century as one of the mainstays in our Religious Education Program. Mike has taught a whole generation of Middle School young people in the ways of their faith, which is no mean accomplishment! In honoring Mike, I want to honor as well, all the catechists who serve in Faith Formation, and who began their new year last Sunday. The Faith Formation program is the oldest component of our parish, dating back to April 18, 1908, even before the parish itself was formed. Our handing-on of the faith is one of the principal concerns of our parish. Congratulations to Mike, and thank you to all our catechists.

- On Saturday, October 14, the Paterson Diocese will sponsor a **one-day pilgrimage** to the National Shrine. His 2002 canonization by Pope John Paul II was the biggest event Rome had ever seen. So large were the crowds that not only Saint Peter's Square was filled, but also the large square in front of Saint John Lateran Basilica.

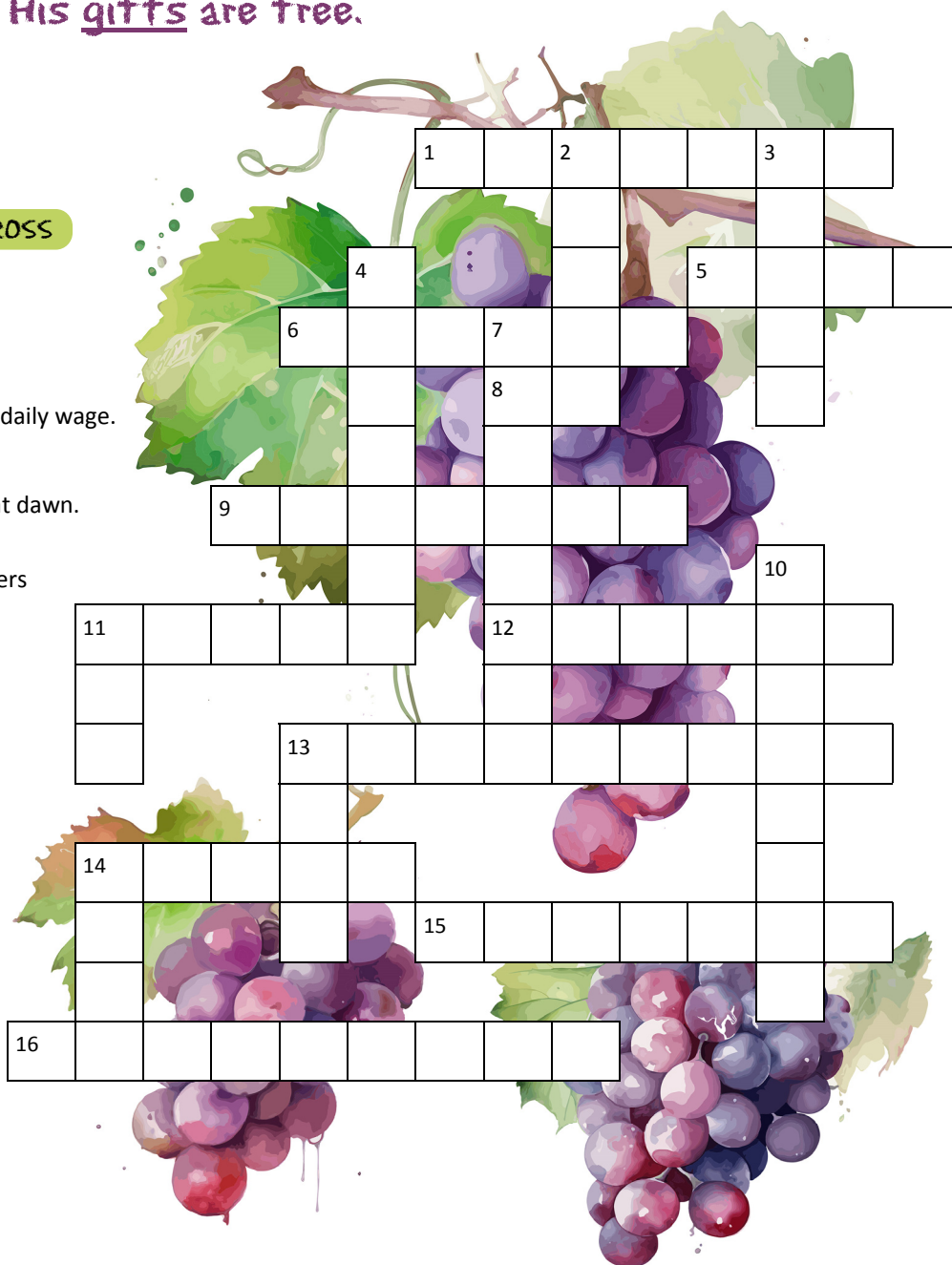
