## BY THE WAY . . .

- This afternoon at the Cathedral of Saint John the Baptist on Paterson, Bishop Kevin Sweeney will present the annual **Diocesan Vivere Christus Award** to one person or family from each of the parishes of the diocese. Michael is involved in a number of facets of our parish life, including working on The Feast, serving for a quarter-century as a Sixth Grade Religious Formation Catechist, and as our parish attorney. Congratulations Michael!

- Every now and then it does not hurt to go over the basics! The above two announcements both make strong mention of the **Paterson Diocese**. But what exactly does that mean? A “diocese” is a geographical region in the Catholic Church presided over by a Bishop. It is often referred to in Church terminology as “the local Church.”

In the United States there are 195 dioceses, five of them located in New Jersey. The first U.S. diocese was established at Baltimore, Maryland in 1789, and covered the entire country as **it then** existed, including New Jersey. Two of our parishes (St. Joseph's, West Milford and St. Vincent's, Madison date back that far). In 1808 Baltimore was raised to archdiocesan status, and four new dioceses were established at Boston, New York, Philadelphia and Bardonia, Kentucky. For the next half-century New Jersey would be split between the New York and Philadelphia Dioceses. The parishes in Boonton, Dover, Mendham, Morristown, Paterson and Whippany date from this period.

In July 1853, Pope Pius IX created ten new dioceses across the United States including San Francisco, Brooklyn, and Newark, N.J. For the first time New Jersey was a separate diocese in its own right. The growth of Catholicism in the Garden State was so swift, that in 1881, the fourteen central and southern counties of the state were cut off and formed into a second New Jersey diocese at Trenton.

At the time of the 1881 division, the Bishop of Newark, Michael Corrigan, predicted that that would not be the last division of the Newark Diocese. He foresaw that the continued growth would lead to still another division. He expected that Newark would hold on to Essex, Union and Morris Counties, and that the other four (Bergen, Hudson, Passaic and Sussex) would become a Diocese of either Jersey City or Paterson. Corrigan based his prediction on the ways in which the counties were connected by the railroads, then the principal means of transportation.

Fifty-six years later, half of Bishop Corrigan's prediction came true. On December 8, 1937 Pope Pius XI raised Newark to archdiocesan status, and the following day announced the division of both Newark and Trenton, with two new New Jersey Dioceses at Paterson and Camden. Highways had replaced railroads as the principal means of transportation, and the

growing highway system connected the counties differently than the railroads. That, and other considerations, meant that the new Paterson Diocese would consist of Morris, Passaic and Sussex Counties, with the church of Saint John the Baptist, the oldest and largest in the City of Paterson, designated as the Cathedral of the new diocese. (In 1981, Pope St. John Paul II divided the Trenton Diocese again, and created the Metuchen Diocese in four central New Jersey counties).

Today, the Paterson Diocese consists of 108 parish communities – 47 in Morris County, 44 in Passaic County, and 16 in Sussex Country, presided over by Bishop Kevin J. Sweeney, the eighth Bishop of Paterson.

## TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

**"I know how to live in humble circumstances; I know also how to live with abundance. In every circumstance and in all things I have learned the secret of being well fed and of going hungry, of living in abundance and of being in need. I can do all things in him who strengthens me...My God will fully supply whatever you need....Go out, therefore into the main roads and invite to the feast whomever you find."**

We live as a truly blessed people. Whatever we have is a gift from God. As Paul speaks to us today, it is a special moment to ask what do I really need, but also what do I have that I can do without. In our area many storage facilities have opened to provide space for the many possession we do not readily use. For some there is need for temporary storage, but for so many, the storage will go on permanently.

Besides observing these facilities, please note there are so many struggling and in need. It allows us to consider what do I have that I can share with someone else? We are assured that God will supply with necessities. What shall I do with my excess? The gospel tells us to go out and invite someone else to the feast. There are countless opportunities to provide clothing, furniture, and groceries to less fortunate who are our neighbors.

Why not use as a mantra this week the words of St. Paul, 'I can do all things in Him who strengthens me.'

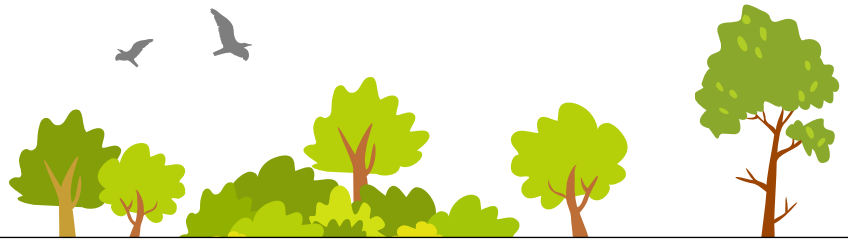
