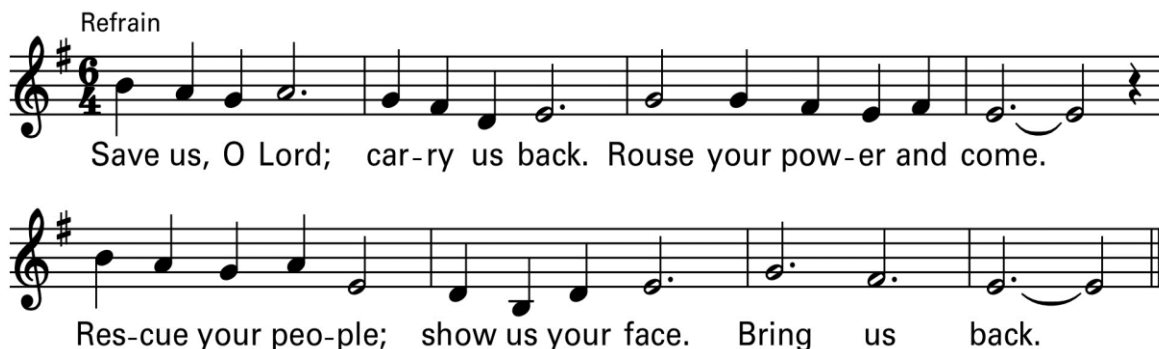

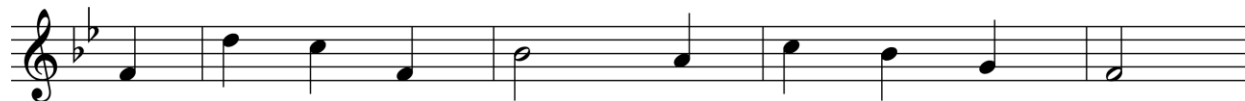

BY THE WAY

- Next Sunday morning at the 8:30 A.M. Mass we are happy to welcome Chief Joseph Speranza, and the men and women of the **Hawthorne Fire Department** for their annual Mass for the deceased members of the department. We are all grateful for the mantle of protection the Fire Department extends over our community, and at the same time, pray that they may be able to conduct their vital service in safety and peace.
- Unfortunately, the Hawthorne Borough **Interfaith Prayer Service for Peace in the Middle East**, which was scheduled to take place in our church this evening, has had to be cancelled. Perhaps at some point it may be able to be rescheduled. In the meantime, please continue your prayers for peace in this troubled part of the world.
- One of the important programs that receives funding from the **Diocesan Ministries Appeal** is Nazareth Village, our diocesan home for retired priests. The priests who live at Nazareth Village have faithfully served our diocese for many years. And many continue to celebrate Mass at local parishes. The Grace of the Sacrament: In sickness and in health. This past week was a sad one for me. Twice in the same week I had to bury a woman who died all too young of breast cancer. One was 61, the other 62. Although they did not know each other, they seemed to me to be very similar. They were both beautiful, vivacious, strong, capable, a little flirty – and tough as nails. In my experience of them I always felt I was encountering a lost character from the movie, “Steel Magnolias.”

I spoke to the two husbands at the wakes. The one was always a man of few words, and, through tears, he simply said, “We did all right together, didn’t we Father?” The other was much more reflective, and talked about the vows they had taken before me 33 years earlier. “I didn’t know then that those vows were so strong, and that they would give me the strength to get through this.” This is what Catholics call “the grace of the sacrament;” the strength that God gives us through the Sacrament to make good on the promises we make.

Today, for all too many, Marriage has been secularized. In many cases, marriage venues have supplanted the Church as the sole locus for the wedding. A secular celebration occurs, everyone has a good time, everyone wishes the couple well, but the Sacrament of Marriage and its grace is not celebrated.

For those whose marriage falls into this category, and are desirous of celebrating the Sacrament of Marriage, or to use another term, “validating before Christ and his Church what

was done in a secular manner originally,” please contact one of the priests to arrange for a sacramental celebration.

THANKSGIVING FOOD DRIVE

The parish Social Services Ministry is preparing for the collection and distribution of Thanksgiving Day food for the needy families. This year we are inviting parishioners to donate a box/laundry basket/bag, filled with items for a traditional Thanksgiving dinner, and/or a turkey.

Among suggested items for the baskets are such non-perishable items as:

Canned goods: vegetables, turkey gravy, cranberry sauce, fruit, soup,
Pumpkin, yams, chicken or turkey broth.

Package goods : rice (white, brown yellow, wild, mixes), instant mashed potatoes
Stuffing mix, Jell-O, Pudding mix, cake/brownie/cookie mixes, icing, cookies, biscuit mix,
ready-made piecrust mix, pie-fillings and raisins.

Other: applesauce, coffee, tea, hot Chocolate, Parmalat or similar shelf stable milk, evaporated milk,
fruit juices, nuts, boxed chocolate candy, disposable roasting pans, can openers, napkins.

**Please avoid glass bottles or jars, due to the possibility of breaking;
No refrigerated or frozen items, no outdated products and no opened packages.**

If you would like to participate in this effort, please complete the tear-off form below, and place it in one of the baskets at the doors of the church until Sunday November 12. If you would like to help, but are unable to provide an entire basket, we suggest that you invite your friends, neighbors and/or extended family to join you in putting one together.

Baskets/boxes/turkeys will be collected at the rectory garage (behind the church) **Thursday evening, November 16 between 7:00 and 8:00 P.M. Please only use the Diamond Bridge Avenue entrance to the parking lot when dropping off the basket/turkey. You may also drop off at the rectory from November 13 through November 16.**

Smaller quantities of food are also welcome. These may be left in front of St. Joseph's altar in church. The Social Services Ministry thanks you for your support. Our Thanksgiving food drive has been very successful in the past, and this a tangible sign of our parish's generosity and commitment to live out the gospel values. As Jesus himself has told us, *"Whatever you do for the least of my brothers and sisters, you do for me"*. (Matthew 25:40)
