ATTENTION SENIORS!

Passaic County Dept. of Senior Services provides one hot meal Monday through Friday at the Hawthorne Senior Center (Ambulance Corps Building), 970 Goffle Rd. There is a minimal fee, and it's a friendly environment conducive to socialization. The Center also conducts various activities such as parties, trips, lectures, etc. that meet the needs of participants. The Center is open from 8:30 A.M. to 1:30 P.M. For further information, call 973 423 1027 or the County Nutrition Office at 973 569 4060.

And if you need transportation: The Passaic County Paratransit Program maintains a fleet of vehicles, which provide transportation for the county's senior citizens and disabled residents in need of nonemergency rides to medical appointments, shopping centers, county-run nutrition and adult day care sites, and for the disabled residents to attend group work programs. Special lift vans are available to accommodate non-ambulatory individuals. There is no fee for this service, however a donation of \$2.00 per trip is suggested.
