



BY THE WAY . . .

- Here we go again! Today is the **First Sunday of Advent**, the beginning of the new Church liturgical year, a new opening of grace for each one of us as we open up the Gospel of Mark and begin to read from him through the Sundays of this year. The growing number of homes that I see decorated in lights as I drive around town remind us of what we do in church as we slowly, almost teasingly, light the Advent Wreath candles week by week. The play on light in church and in our homes reminds us that this is the darkest time of the year. But, beginning with Christmas each day will grow a little longer and light will return, atmospherically and spiritually as we allow the light of Christ to grow in our hearts and lives. Happy Advent to all; use the season well.

- I am happy this afternoon to welcome our own parishioner, **Dr. Dianne Traflet**, Associate Dean of Immaculate Conception School of Theology at Seton Hall University, as she leads the women of our parish through our annual **Advent by Candlelight** Advent reflection.

- The **Sacrament of Penance** is a marvelous way to celebrate Advent and prepare for Christmas. In addition to our regular Saturday afternoon opportunities for Confession (4:30-5:15 P.M.), there will be two other opportunities for Penance. One is this coming Tuesday morning at 9:00 A.M. when there will be five priests hearing the Confessions of the Saint Anthony's School children. Any adults who show up at that time can also be accommodated. The second is on Tuesday December 19, when Confessions will be heard from 3:30 to 4:30 in the afternoon, and again at 7:00 to 8:00 in the evening.

- This coming Friday, December 8, is the **Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception**, patronal feast of the United States of America, and a holyday of obligation. Masses will be at 7:30 P.M. on Thursday evening, and at 7:00 A.M., 9:00 A.M. and 12:05 P.M. on Friday.

- This coming Saturday morning, December 10, Bishop Sweeney is hosting a diocesan-wide celebration of **Our Lady of Guadalupe** at 10:30 A.M. at Saint Peter the Apostle Church in Parsippany.

- **Seminarian Advancement.** This Wednesday, Bishop Kevin Sweeney will install our parishioner, Thomas McKinley, as a Lector during Mass in the chapel at Pope John XXIII National Seminary in Weston, Massachusetts.

Next Sunday at Mass in Saint James Church in Springfield, Cardinal Joseph Tobin of Newark will admit our resident seminarian, Carlos Penagos, to Candidacy for Diaconate and Priesthood.

Both of these rites represent significant steps in the road to priesthood ordination. Congratulations to both men. Please continue to keep Tom and Carlos and all their classmates in your prayers.

- During this season of Advent, we look forward with hope and joy. WEEK 1, evening lighting prayer

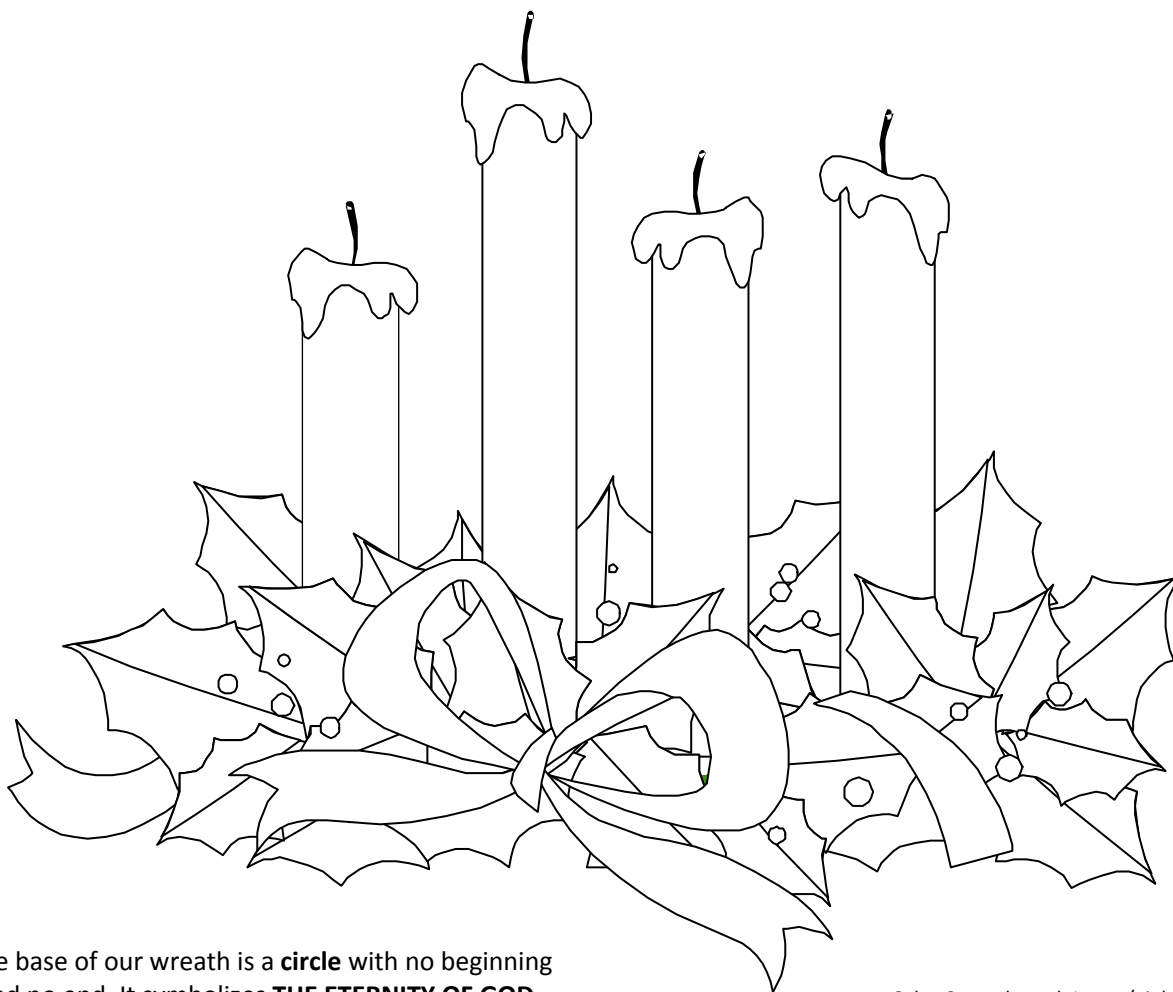
Prayer said by Father or head of household

"O God, by whose word all things are sanctified, pour forth Thy blessings upon this wreath and grant that we who use it may prepare our hearts for the coming of Christ and may receive from Thee abundant graces. Through Christ our Lord, Amen."



The base of our wreath is a **circle** with no beginning and no end. It symbolizes **THE ETERNITY OF GOD**.

We decorate the base with **EVERGREENS** which represent **CONTINUOUS LIFE**.

Color 3 purple and 1 rose/pink candle.
Draw a flame on 1 purple candle and
color the holly leaves green.

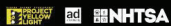

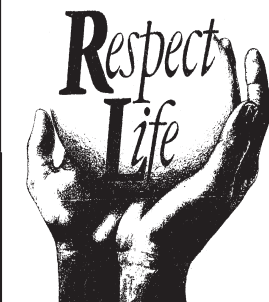
