BY THE WAY . . .

- One of the highlights each year of the Advent Season is our presentation of **Advent Lessons and Carols** which will take place next Sunday evening at 6:00 P.M. here in our church. In the English-speaking world, the most famous Lessons and Carols presentation takes place each year on Christmas Eve from the Chapel of King's College at Cambridge University. Although only a small number can actually attend the service, millions of people begin their Christmas each year by listening to the service through the BBC. Ours is the second most famous presentation.

Although it is steeped in nine biblical texts and many hymns which are ancient, the service itself is a relatively new addition to the Christmas celebration. It was first performed in 1918, just four weeks after the armistice ending World War I. It was conceived by the chaplain of the college, who himself had served as a chaplain in the war, as a gift to the City of Cambridge commemorating all the men who had lost their lives in the Great War, and as an opening to renewed faith for all those who had lost their faith during the horrors of that conflict.

So, if there is someone special whose memory you are holding close this Christmas, or if you are in need of an opening to deeper faith, come for this hour next Sunday and be soothed and nourished.

- The **Sacrament of Penance** is a marvelous way to celebrate Advent and prepare for Christmas. In addition to our regular Saturday afternoon opportunities for Confession (4:30-5:15 P.M.), there will be two other opportunities for Penance. This is on Tuesday December 19, when Confessions will be heard from 3:30 to 4:30 in the afternoon, and again at 7:00 to 8:00 in the evening.

- One of the beautiful feasts that marks the Advent Season is that of **Our Lady of Guadalupe** on December 12. This feast, commemorating the apparition of the Blessed Virgin Mary to a native Mexican, Saint Juan Diego, on the hill of Tepeyac outside Mexico City in 1531. The custom in many Mexican communities is to honor Mary serenading here all through the night leading up to the Feast. At the actual Basilica in Mexico City, prominent Mexican musicians of every persuasion take their turn singing before the original image of Mary all through the night. Tune into *Univision* (channel 6) at midnight this Monday and see parts of the *Mananitas a la Virgen* from Mexico City and other places around our country.

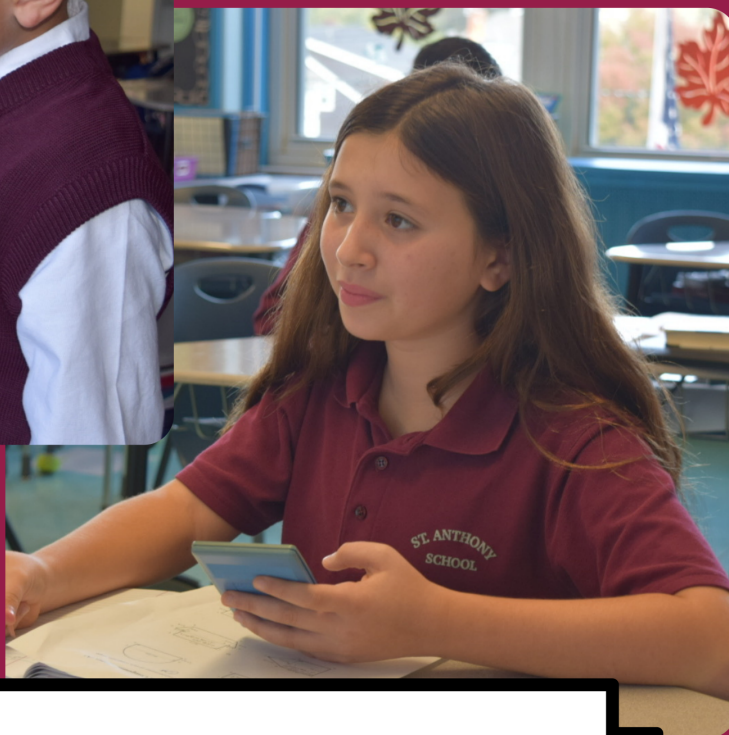

ATTENTION SENIORS!

Passaic County Dept. of Senior Services provides one hot meal Monday through Friday at the Hawthorne Senior Center (Ambulance Corps Building), 970 Goffle Rd. There is a minimal fee, and it's a friendly environment conducive to socialization. The Center also conducts various activities such as parties, trips, lectures, etc. that meet the needs of participants. The Center is open from 8:30 A.M. to 1:30 P.M. For further information, call 973 423 1027 or the County Nutrition Office at 973 569 4060.

And if you need transportation: The County's Paratransit Program maintains a fleet of vehicles that provide transportation for the county's senior citizens and disabled residents in need of non-emergency rides to medical appointments, shopping centers, county-run nutrition and adult day care sites, and for the disabled residents to attend group work programs. Special lift vans are available to accommodate non-ambulatory individuals. There is no fee for this service, however, a donation of \$2.00 per trip is suggested. Call 973-305-5756 between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to reserve a trip. Trips may be one-way, round trip or recurring trips. All rides are scheduled on a first come first serve basis

SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

“Here begins the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God. In Isaiah the prophet it is written: ‘I send my messenger before to prepare your way’: a herald's voice in the desert crying, ‘Make ready the way of the Lord, clear him a straight path.’ Thus it was that John the Baptizer appeared in the desert proclaiming a baptism of repentance which led to the forgiveness of sins...One more powerful than I is to come after me. I am not fit to stoop and untie his sandal strap. I have baptized you in water, he will baptize you in the Holy Spirit.”

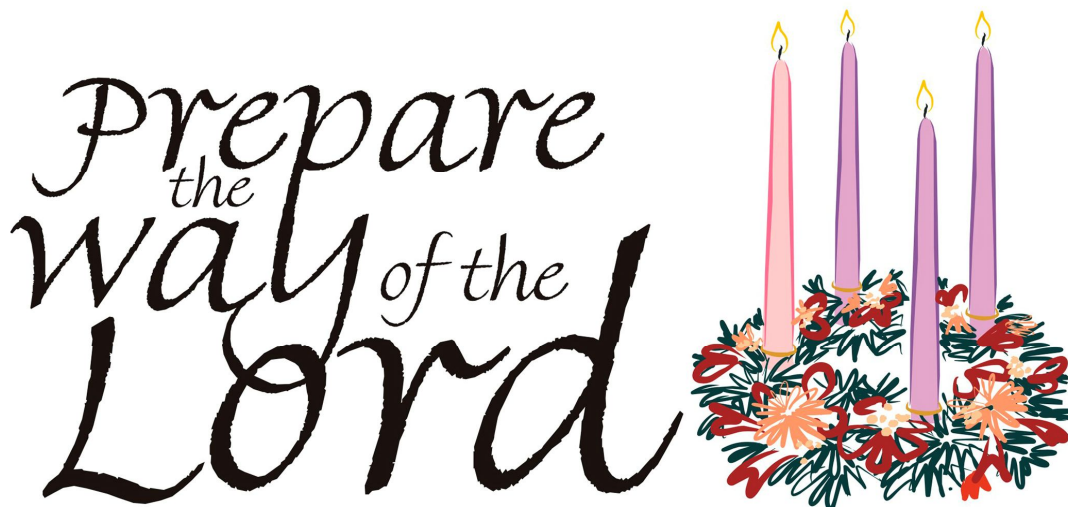
We meet John the Baptist, the second principal figure of advent, exhorting us to take seriously the need for preparing for the Lord in our lives today. We begin with ourselves, making sure that with the Lord's help, that we are living the life of grace, His plan and gift for us. We seek His gift in the sacraments of Penance and the Eucharist.

While we become preoccupied with Christmas preparations, how sad that we sometimes fail to prepare ourselves, or fail to encourage others to join with us in what really matters, our readiness to discover anew the presence of Christ. John's reference to Isaiah provides the direction that we all need - make ready, clear the path. 'Come Lord Jesus.'
