## BY THE WAY . . .

- I call your attention to the fact that Ash Wednesday is only seven weeks away. I need all the authors for this year's **Lenten Book** to hand in their submissions forthwith!
- The first **Eucharistic Adoration** of the New Year will take place this coming Friday, January 5, the first Friday of the month at 7:30 P.M. in the church.
- This Saturday, January 6, the **Saint Joseph's Men's Group** will meet for prayer and discussion from 8:30 to 9:30 A.M. beginning in the church. All men are welcome.
- On December 19 of this past week, the Holy See issued the "**Declaration *Fiducia Supplicans* – On the Pastoral Meaning of Blessings.**" While the declaration "remains firm on the traditional doctrine of the Church about marriage, not allowing any type of liturgical rite or blessing similar to a liturgical rite that can create confusion," at the same time, in broadening and enriching the classical understanding of blessings, it admits "the possibility of blessing couples in irregular situations and same-sex couples without officially validating their status or changing in any way the Church's perennial teaching in marriage."

While there will be, and already has been, much discussion and debate on this document – both by those who have read it and those who have not, I thought the last paragraph was especially beautiful, and I repeat it here for all our reflection as we end the old year.

*This world needs blessings, and we can give blessings and receive blessings. The Father loves us, and the only thing that remains for us is the joy of blessing him, and the joy of thanking him, and of learning from him. In this way every brother and sister will be able to feel that, in the Church, they are always pilgrims, always beggars, always loved, and, despite everything, always blessed.*

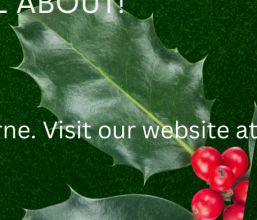

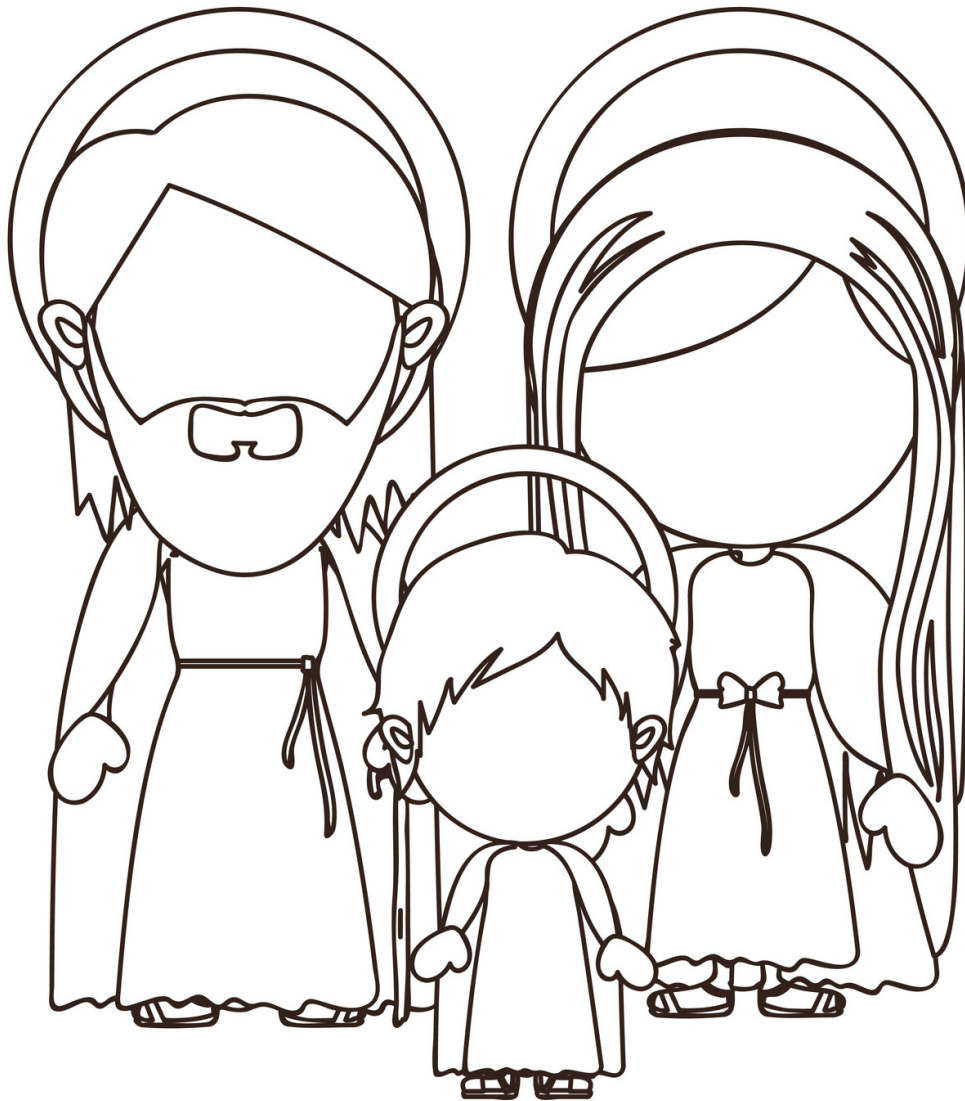
