BY THE WAY . . .

- **Thank you** – A number of years ago on Thanksgiving, my mother and I were all set to go to my brother's house for the feast. Instead, I got an early morning call from my brother announcing that he was in bed with a twenty-four hour virus and he was not cooking. My mother and I scrambled and wound up for Thanksgiving Dinner at the old Traveler's Diner in Dover. It was the first time in my life (and to date the only time) that I had eaten Thanksgiving Dinner outside of a family home. I was shocked at how crowded the diner was. I had no idea that that many people went out for Thanksgiving. But, even more, I was surprised at how many people, young and old, were eating alone for one reason or another.

In all the hectic activity of a shortened Advent-Christmas cycle this year, Saint Anthony's parishioner still found the time and the resources to extend Thanksgiving and Christmas dinners to several hundred needy people from our area. Not one of them had to eat alone on Thanksgiving or Christmas this year. They dined with us. Thank you to all who contributed and all who facilitated.

- **Culture Wars** – In 2006 the Boston Red Sox scheduled their Opening Day game for Good Friday. Rather cheekily they asked the Archbishop of Boston, Cardinal Sean O'Malley, O.F.M. Cap. for a dispensation to allow Catholics to eat hot dogs at the stadium on one of the only two universal fast days of the year. They were a little surprised by the heated response they got from the Cardinal, ignoring the request for the dispensation, but instead complaining about the anti-Catholicism of the Red Sox scheduling the opening game in opposition to one of the holiest days of the Christian calendar.

This year we are set up for another such clash, as Valentine's Day falls on the other universal day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics, namely, Ash Wednesday. It will be interesting to see what choices people make – ashes or veal *parmigiana*. I will have to ask the local eating establishments about who ran out of fish options first.

- **Always and everywhere:** Last week I traveled down to Burlington County to concelebrate a funeral for Father Michael Parisi's mother at Saint Mary of the Lakes Church in Medford. I had never been in this town or this church before. It was a 70s-80s modern church with virtually no statues. However, Saint Anthony of Padua made the cut and was present.
