## BY THE WAY . . .

- Now that we have begun the **Season of Lent** in earnest, I want to point out to you that this year, once again, every Catholic church in the Paterson Diocese will have the **Sacrament of Penance** available on Monday evenings from 7:00 to 8:30 P.M. This is in addition to our regular Penance hours on Saturday afternoon from 4:30 to 5:15 P.M.

- This week will also see the launch of three different seasonal offerings. On Tuesday evenings at 7:30 P.M. in the church, Father Ray will offer a series called **Herstory: Women in the Church** – a look at the History of the Church through twenty centuries from the female perspective.

On Thursday evenings at 7:30 P.M. in the Cafeteria, Father Frank will offer a series called **Feeding the Body and Soul**. This will look at the Scriptures for the Lenten Sundays paired with various foods which trace their origin to the Catholic tradition (i.e. pretzels, Coquille St.-Jacques, etc.). Samples will be served.

On Friday mornings, Sister Betty Ann, F.M.A. will offer **Around the Lenten Circle** at 9:00 A.M. in the school. This Bible Study will explore and pray over the Scriptures for the Lenten Sundays. A registration form is provided elsewhere in this bulletin.

- **The Stations of the Cross**, a devotion particularly attuned to the Lenten Season, are prayed in common each Friday evening of Lent at 7:30 P.M. On Friday, March 1, the Stations of the Cross will be combined with our monthly Eucharistic Holy Hour. The devotion prayerfully recounts the last journey of Jesus in Jerusalem from Pilate's judgement seat to the Mount Calvary. It is the same devotion that is prayed in the streets of Jerusalem by pilgrims carrying a cross on the Via Dolorosa.

- During the Superbowl this past week there was a commercial, featuring the actor Mark Wahlberg, inviting us to use the Season of Lent well. Lent invites us to a deeper practice of prayer. In the modern age of technology there are **many different websites and podcasts** that offer to help us with prayer and reflection, wherever we may find ourselves. Among those available are:

USCCB – the United State Conference of Catholic Bishops site not only has the daily Mass readings, but also a three-minute meditation by a different person each day;

Hallow – featuring the actors Mark Wahlburg and Jonathan Roumie;

Bible Gateway – providing different avenues for Scripture reading, study and prayer;

IBreviary – leads a person through using the Liturgy of the Hours for prayer;

### **FREE MEALS FOR HOMEBOUND SENIORS**

Home Delivered Meal Service (Meals on Wheels) is available to County homebound older adults who are unable to provide for their own nutritional needs due to acute/chronic illness or handicap. Please note that applicants must meet specific program requirements to be eligible for service. Service includes the delivery of one hot meal per day, Monday through Friday. In addition, weekend service is also available if needed. Applications are taken by phone. For more information, or to see if you qualify, please call (973)569-4099.

### **ATTENTION SENIORS!**

Passaic County Dept. of Senior Services provides one hot meal Monday through Friday at the Hawthorne Senior Center (Ambulance Corps Building), [970 Goffle Rd.](#) There is a minimal fee, and it's a friendly environment conducive to socialization. The Center also conducts various activities such as parties, trips, lectures, etc. that meet the needs of participants. The Center is open from 8:30 A.M. to 1:30 P.M. For further information, call 973 423 1027 or the County Nutrition Office at 973 569 4060. And if you need transportation: The Passaic County Paratransit Program maintains a fleet of vehicles, which provide transportation for the county's senior citizens age 60 and over and disabled residents in need of non-emergency rides to medical appointments, shopping centers, county run nutrition and adult day care sites, and for disabled residents to attend group work programs. Special lift vans are available to accommodate non-ambulatory individuals; service animals and portable oxygen will be accommodated. There is no fee for this service, however a donation of \$2.00 per trip is suggested. All donations are used to support Paratransit. To schedule a ride, please call (973) 305-5756 Monday through Friday, 8 A.M. to 4 P.M.

### **FAITH & GRIEF SUPPORT GATHERINGS**

Open to all faiths, Faith & Grief Gatherings are opportunities for those mourning the loss of a loved one to gather together and be strengthened through sharing, scripture, prayer & reflection. ## LET'S MAKE PRETZELS

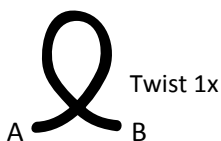
### INGREDIENTS

1 package dry yeast  
1 1/2 cups warm water  
1 tsp. sugar  
1/2 tsp. salt  
4 cups flour  
Kosher salt  
Water to hold salt on

Latin - Bracellae "Little arms", the original Lenten bread dating back to the 4th century.

Place yeast, sugar & warm water in a large bowl and let stand. Add flour & salt, mix well and knead to form smooth ball.

Divide into 12 pieces and roll each into a "rope" about 10-12 inches long. Form into a pretzel and place on baking sheet, brush with water and sprinkle with kosher salt. Let rise slightly and bake at 425° about 12-15 minutes.
