Dear Fellow Mary Queen Parishioners,

The MQHR Finance Council respectfully submits to you the parish financial report for fiscal year ending June 20, 2025. Thank you for your generous offertory and capital campaign gifts throughout the 2024-2025 fiscal year.

During the year, the offertory was \$2.2 million and increased 5.3% over the previous year. In addition, the capital campaign brought in nearly \$1.2 million. While funding improved last year, the longer-term effect of inflation and rising expenses requires close monitoring and will be managed accordingly.

As for the MQHR school, this important ministry has continued to have a meaningful impact on so many of our youth, as enrollment has grown, reaching over 485 students for the current school year. Funding from tuition, school programs and scholarships has grown as well in supporting school operating expenses as the subsidy from the parish has remained relatively stable.

With the capital campaign funds collected and additional school funds, we were able to pay down the debt on the Education Life Center (ELC), which had a balance of \$1.2 million at the end of the fiscal year, compared to \$3.6 million the prior year. The debt was refinanced in June at a fixed rate of 5.48% for a term of five years, matching the timeline of our capital campaign.

We are extremely thankful for the sacrifices that so many have made to our parish, through the offertory, the capital campaign and for all those volunteering their time and talent. We pray for your continued support as we seek to remain steadfast in fulfilling our mission; To receive God's love, proclaim the greatness of the Lord,
