From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

As of this writing, the archdiocese of Newark has not changed the requirements to be enforced during this coronavirus outbreak. Besides the following, we have removed all the holy water from the fonts at the entrances of the church. We have decided to cancel our St. Patrick celebration planned for Sunday afternoon as well as our Religious Education classes this weekend and this coming Tuesday as we take into consideration the health and welfare of all our parishioners here at St. Mary. Please, if not feeling well, see your doctor immediately. Let us all pray for our country and our world as we face this challenge and continue on this Lenten journey.

- The Archdiocese has always advised the faithful that sickness is a valid reason not to attend Mass or other Church gatherings. As such, any individual who is sick or has flu-like symptoms is urged to stay home. The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is broadcast on several television channels and the sick can make a "spiritual communion" until they return to good health.
- The sign of peace should be exchanged without physical contact.
- Distribution of the Precious Blood of Christ from the chalice to parishioners is to be suspended. Furthermore, no member of the faithful is obliged to receive the Body of Christ on the tongue.

Through the intercession of St. Patrick and St. Joseph, may God keep us safe and help us as we walk this journey of faith together. Thank you for your attention in this serious matter.

This is a great way to show your support for the homeless working families and their children that we house during the year.






