Senior Van Transportation Service Available

The Borough of Closter offers a joint service for Senior Van Transportation to Closter residents who are nonseniors in need driving transportation medical to appointments, grocery stores, senior activities and more within a ten mile radius of Closter. Together with Haworth and Harrington Park, the shared service program is helping to meet the needs of our residents. appointments Medical take preference during scheduling of transportation, and patience is asked as you may need to arrive early to an appointment or wait for the van to return to pick you up. The service consists of trained and caring individuals who work to meet the needs of the participants. participate in this programs, persons must be seniors who are non-drivers (or temporarily unable to drive), independent to walk to the vehicle and depart the vehicle unassisted and who are flexible in the pick-up, drop-off times for medical appointments. The Senior Van service operates Monday through Friday between 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM. Reservations must be made 48 hours in advance. Sacrament Certificate Requests



Why Register at St. Mary's?

Every Catholic should be registered in a parish. Beside the active support and involvement that the registration enables, parish registration is also a mandatory condition for many sacraments including Baptism and Matrimony and being a sponsor or godparent. It is therefore important to register at St. Mary's as soon as you start worshipping with us regularly.

- You may receive verification letters to sponsor individuals for sacraments, receive sacraments yourself or your child (i.e. marriage, baptism).
- You will receive end of the year tax contribution statements.
- You will be personally invited to gatherings to meet the staff and other parishioners.
- The parish will know the demographics and respond to needs. Further, the Archdiocese will know that our parish has a healthy base of registered, supportive parishioners.
