From the Faith Formation Coordinator

Good day parishioners,

There is something major happening in our Catholic Church right now that you may not be aware of.

Last year, every parishioner had the opportunity to participate in a survey for the "Synod for Synodality", a "journeying together" for the Catholic Church. You would have answered questions about our individual church and also questions about the Catholic Church as a whole. Those questions boiled down to how does this "journeying together" take place today on different levels and what steps is the Holy Spirit inviting us to take in order to grow as a synodal Church. The "Synod for Synodality" is only the 16th synod ever in the Catholic Church and the first one to include lay people so if you participated, you made history.

Maybe you thought nothing was ever going to be done about that survey. Well, Cardinal Tobin, C.Ss.R., Archbishop of Newark, will be sharing weekly messages via video from Rome during the XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops during the month of October. This synod will not only include bishops but also members of Religious Orders, priests and deacons, and as I mentioned, lay people. It represents a "fundamental stage" in the synodal journey initiated by Pope Francis in October 2021.

"In a recent video message to the faithful of the Archdiocese of Newark, Cardinal Tobin explains that Synodality means "journeying together." The Church has gathered in synods since its very beginning for the purpose of effectively carrying out its mission to proclaim the Gospel to all nations and peoples. As Pope Francis reminds us frequently, our journeying together is what manifests the nature of the Church as the pilgrim and missionary People of God, he said."

If you are interested, you can view Cardinal Tobin's weekly messages by going to www.rcan.org and stay on top of everything going on in Rome during this synodal period. If not, then please at least pray for this synod. This prayer, an adaptation of a prayer that has historically been used at Councils, Synods, and other Church gatherings for hundreds of years, may be used which was taken from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB).

We stand before You, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in Your name.

With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts;

Teach us the way we must go and how we are to pursue it.

We are weak and sinful; do not let us promote disorder.

Do not let ignorance lead us down the wrong path nor partiality influence our actions.

Let us find in You our unity so that we may journey together to eternal life and not stray from the way of truth and what is right.

All this we ask of You, who are at work in every place and time, in the communion of the Father and the Son, forever and ever.

Amen.

- You may receive verification letters to sponsor individuals for sacraments, receive sacraments yourself or your child (i.e. marriage, baptism).
- You will receive end of the year tax contribution statements.
- You will be personally invited to gatherings to meet the staff and other parishioners.
- The parish will know the demographics and respond to needs. Further, the Archdiocese will know that our parish has a healthy base of registered, supportive parishioners.
