Beside the active support and involvement that the registration enables, parish registration is also a mandatory condition for many sacraments including Baptism and Matrimony and being a sponsor or godparent. It is therefore important to register at St. Mary's as soon as you start worshipping with us regularly.

- You may receive verification letters to sponsor individuals for sacraments, receive sacraments yourself or your child (i.e. marriage, baptism).
- You will receive end of the year tax contribution statements.
- You will be personally invited to gatherings to meet the staff and other parishioners.
- The parish will know the demographics and respond to needs. Further, the Archdiocese will know that our parish has a healthy base of registered, supportive parishioners.

#### From the Faith Formation Coordinator


Good day parishioners,

Last week I wrote about the historic "Synod for Synodality" that is happening right now in our Catholic Church. There is another event that is happening in our Church right now, a Eucharistic Revival. On June 19, 2022, the Feast of Corpus Christi, the United States Council of Catholic Bishops began a three-year focus on the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist that is intended to be a National Eucharistic Revival!

We can all see that our world is hurting. We all need healing, yet many of us are separated from the very source of our strength, the Eucharist. "Jesus Christ invites us to return to the source and summit of our faith in the celebration of the Eucharist. The National Eucharistic Revival is a movement to restore understanding and devotion to this great mystery here in the United States by helping us renew our worship of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist." - <a href="mailto:eucharisticrevival.org">eucharisticrevival.org</a>

During this Eucharistic Revival, Jesus will be accompanying people in our country across the United States lighting hearts on fire. There will be 4 routes, 60 days on the road, 1000 Hosts, traveling 6,500 miles with over 100,000 participants. The four routes will originate in San Francisco, CA - the St. Junipero Serra Route, Mississippi, MN - the Marian Route, New Haven, CT - the St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Route, and then lastly Indianapolis, IN, where all these flames will ablaze together at the National Eucharistic Congress in July 2024.

Sounds like too much? Not prepared for a pilgrimage? Well, there is a very special 3-night encounter happening in our very own Cathedral Basilica in Newark on November  $2^{nd} - 4^{th}$ ; Thursday and Friday events will begin at 7:00 PM and Saturday will begin at 5:00 PM . I've included the flier below.
