







Our Lady of Mount Carmel school, a Catholic Institution, is devoted to the development of the whole student.



ACADEMICS

Each step from Pre-K 3 through to Grade 8 offers a unique and tailored curriculum.

Pre-K 3 Program



➤ Specifically designed for 3 year olds.

➤ Half Day and Full-Day options available.

➤ Frequent free play to master skills of cooperation, sharing, and social interaction.



Pre-K 4 Program



➤ Program offers an academic curriculum.

➤ Program cultivates students' independence, self-discipline, social/emotional development, and creativity.

➤ Prepares students with skills necessary for smooth transition to Kindergarten.



ACADEMICS

Kindergarten through Grade 4



- Focused development of students' skills in the critical areas of reading, writing, and mathematics.
- With science and technology becoming more integrated. Gospel values are interwoven throughout the curriculum.

Students receive Spanish instruction twice a week, where they explore grammar, sentence structure, vocabulary, and the rich cultures of Spanish-speaking countries.



Middle School (Grades 5 - 8)



- Students rotate between teacher subject specialists who work together as a dedicated team to teach mathematics, history, language arts, and science.
- Students become more independent in their learning as concepts are introduced through project-based tasks and exploration.
