Confirmation 2024- All parishes Confirm at the Cathedral of St. Joseph in Hartford, 140 Farmington Avenue, Hartford, CT. The sacrament of Confirmation is administered on Saturdays and Sundays. We are planning to sign up for an early March or April date. We do not know which dates the Cathedral will be offering for Confirmation in 2024. We hope to have a date for by mid-January. As soon as we secure a date, we will promptly inform everyone. We understand this can make it difficult for planning purposes and travel arrangements for sponsors and family. Please note that if a sponsor is unable to attend on the given date, a substitute can stand in. Also, at this time, there are no limits on the number of family members who can attend the sacrament of Confirmation at the Cathedral.
