From the desk of Fr. Ben...

16 July 2017

St. Paul speaks to us very hopefully of the rich harvest that the joys and struggles of the present are capable of bearing, by God's grace:

"I consider that the sufferings of this present time are as nothing compared with the glory to be revealed for us....We know that all creation is groaning in labor pains even until now; and not only that, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, we also groan within ourselves as we wait for adoption, the redemption of our bodies."

These past weeks have been incredibly busy and full for me (and I believe, for many of you, as well)! I have often been exhausted... but I am also full of joy at what the Lord is doing in my heart, and through me. It is truly a joy to serve you, my parish families, and to serve our seminarians and diocese. I know that the labor and toil of digging in my garden and weeding my beds will bring a rich harvest... and I pray that the same may be true of all the work of our hands!

Work continues to get the rectory at St. Anne's ready to become St. Anne's Convent on August 1, when Sisters Marcelyn, Jacqueline, and Carolee arrive. Again, my gratitude to everyone who is helping!

Work also continues at St. Al's. The Baptismal Font, made of the same beautiful blue-green stone as the altar, has been successfully crated and moved out of the vestibule. It will be shipped to a stone carver in Minnesota to be reconfigured for installation in the main aisle. In the meantime, the old carpet and asbestos tile has been properly removed, and new carpet installed in the vestibule and in the stairwell!

One final stage of work remains: on Saturday, July 29th, I will need the help of many volunteers to remove the old pews in preparation for the removal of the old carpet and underlying asbestos tile. Then new carpet and tile will be laid, and then, finally, the new pews will be installed, all to be finished by mid-August!



God bless each of you and know of my prayers, Sister Ellen


