

From the desk of Fr. Ben... **16 December 2018**



The Third Sunday of Advent.... Rejoice, the Lord is near! We light the third candle, rose, and wear rose vestments as a sign that our Advent Preparation is almost done, we're drawing near the joy of our Christmas Feast!

Our joy should increase and deepen our spiritual preparation for the beauty of the Christmas season which approaches. Our Gospel indicates a powerful way to prepare, from the lips of St. John the Baptist:

"The crowds asked John the Baptist, 'What should we do?' He said to them in reply, 'Whoever has two cloaks should share with the person who has none. And whoever has food should do likewise.' Even tax collectors came to be baptized and they said to him, 'Teacher, what should we do?' He answered them, 'Stop collecting more than what is prescribed.' Soldiers also asked him, 'And what is it that we should do?' He told them, 'Do not practice extortion, do not falsely accuse anyone, and be satisfied with your wages."

What might John the Baptist say to you or me? How might he challenge us to seek reform and renewal in our lives, so as to be ready to receive Jesus with joy?

No better preparation than a good confession! Two more penance services are left, including one at St. Anne's on Monday at 6 pm... come open your heart to God's grace!
