

#### From the desk of Fr. Ben...

"When that servant had left, he found one of his fellow servants who owed him a much smaller amount. He seized him and started to choke him, demanding, 'Pay back what you owe.' Falling to his knees, his fellow serv-

ant begged him, 'Be patient with me, and I will pay you back.' But he refused. Instead, he had the fellow servant put in prison until he paid back the debt."

That's a vivid image, isn't it! Not the place I want to be... and I hope not the place you want to be! If we take seriously God's incredible mercy to us, though, that's the place we go whenever we fail to forgive. As we have received so much mercy, we can only rightly extend it to others.

We have confessions every Sat. now at St. Anne's from 3 pm to 3:45 pm out in the parking lot: just pull up to my car (or Fr. Tom's). We also have confessions at St. Al's just outside the church on Tuesday and Wednesday evenings, and on Friday afternoon. Don't stay away from the mercy seat!

This new school year is off to a GREAT start! Thank you so much to everyone who has helped with many well-attended and successful events! May God continue to guide and bless all the weeks of this semester now well begun!


