#### **Updated Pandemic Practices**

- If you have a positive COVID test or COVID symptoms, please do not come to Mass.
- You may consider wearing a **mask** in church if not fully vaccinated for your own safety and for others.
- Consider sanitizing your hands when you arrive.
- For communion, we will continue to have people come up in 2 rows. Priests will sanitize their hands before beginning to give communion and wear masks.. Please receive communion reverently, either in the hand or on the tongue. In either case, the act of reverence encouraged by the US Bishops is a bow of the head as you step forward to receive.
- Normal collections have resumed.
- The 5:30 pm Saturday and the 7 pm Sunday have more open seating if you are concerned about spacing.

"But David said to Abishai, 'Do not harm him, for who can lay hands on the LORD's anointed and remain unpunished?' So David took the spear and the water jug from their place at Saul's head, and they got away without anyone's seeing or knowing or awakening.... David stood on a remote hilltop .... He said: '...The LORD will reward each man for his justice and faithfulness. Today,

though the LORD delivered you into my grasp, I would not harm the LORD's anointed."

David's actions in the first reading are an illustration of Jesus' teaching in the Gospel! David had Saul in his power and could have easily avenged himself. However, rather than attempt to be the arbiter of justice himself (in effect, to make himself God), David reiterates that the Lord is God, "The LORD will reward each man for his justice and faithfulness."

This confidence in God's justice and mercy is the foundation we need to act on Jesus' teaching! Trusting in God, we can "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful."
