

Priestly Ordination at the Monastery Please pray for Hierodeacon Ambrose, longtime member of Holy Protection Monastery (formerly Holy Transfiguration Skete), as he prepares to be ordained to the priesthood this Thursday (Sept. 8). The monastery has not had a priest since Fr. Basil died in November last year. Fr. Tom or Fr. Ben have been traveling to the Monastery once a week to celebrate Mass for the monks. They are under the jurisdiction of the Ukrainian Rite Eparchy of St. Nicholas in Chicago, which covers the western 2/3rds of the U.S. Bishop Venedykt Aleksiychuk will be performing the ordination according to the Ukrainian Rite. Fr. Tom and Fr. Ben will both be there, so Mass and Adoration are cancelled on Thursday.

"Which of you wishing to construct a tower does not first sit down and calculate the cost to see if there is enough for its completion? Otherwise, after laying the foundation and finding himself unable to finish the work the onlookers should laugh at him and say, 'This one began to build but did not have the resources to finish."

I'm not sure many of us have built towers!?! In Jesus' time, a "watchtower" was a necessity for any compound due to the prevalence of bandits and political instability. Nonetheless, the image is clear

enough... a wise person would take account of how much time, energy, and materials would be needed before beginning. Building a tower is a serious business!

Jesus is comparing this to "the project" of following Him. Jesus isn't asking for part of our lives, or part of our hearts, or part of our minds: He's asking for the whole thing, for everything. He wants us to put our hopes, our dreams, our fears, our loved ones, our own hearts in His Hands! He wants us to recognize the fullness of this call, even this demand, so we can make the choice honestly and follow Him.
