We are in talks with Foster Stained Glass
company in Bryan about setting up stained glass
in our windows in the Church. As suggested
by the Diocesan Worship Office, since we have 7
windows, they could depict the 7 Sacraments.
The cost for a leaded symbolic stained glass
window will be \$5200 per window.

This is the type that we already have in the Church. This addition will highly
complement and compliment those. Despite the price, the leaded symbolic
stained glass window will outlive all of us.

The cost for a faceted symbolic stained glass window will be \$3900 per
window.

This is the type that is at St. Mary in Bremond. Even though it's less in cost,
because of the glass and glue/silicone/sand mixture that may expand in time.
We can only have one type of stained glass on these 7 windows. Several
families can get together and share the expense for a window. Mr. Foster
thinks it a good idea to use leaded over faceted. The existing windows are
leaded and it would be good to stay with the same type. I also feel the light
will be better thru the leaded. He is 75% confident we can have the windows
finished by Easter but we will have to begin ASAP.



FEBRUARY 21 - 23, 2020

This is a mandatory retreat for all
confirmation students per diocesan
requirements. The retreat will be held at
St. Mary, Bremond and it will be a joint
event, St. Mary - Bremond, St. Francis of
