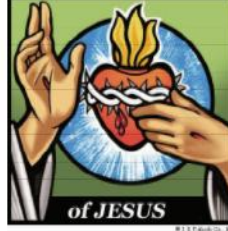
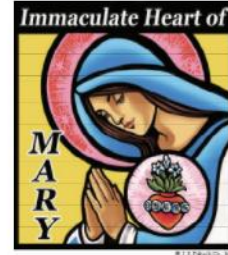

Attendance is required for all employees, volunteers, and members of ministries who work in any capacity with or around children, the elderly, and adults with special needs. These classes are free of charge to all participants, and consists of classroom presentations, printed materials, and DVDs that will focus on the prevention of abuse and the protection of children. Once your initial PGC 5-year anniversary date has been met, you will have 12 months (3 months for employees) from that date to attend a refresher KPA workshop. **Pre-register online at: www.virtusonline.org . No children may attend and childcare will not be provided.**

All attendees are required to present one of the five accepted forms of identification listed below.

- Any State-issued driver's license **OR** State identification
- Passport from any country
- Mexico Consulate Identification card (Matricula Consular) **OR** Guatemala Consulate Identification card

All identification must be current and not expired. When pre-registering for a class, **you must use your name and date of birth as it appears on your identification.**

Individuals who do not have one of the five forms of identification **will not be allowed to attend** the VIRTUS workshop.

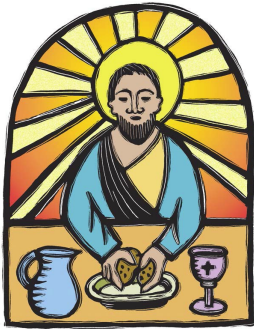

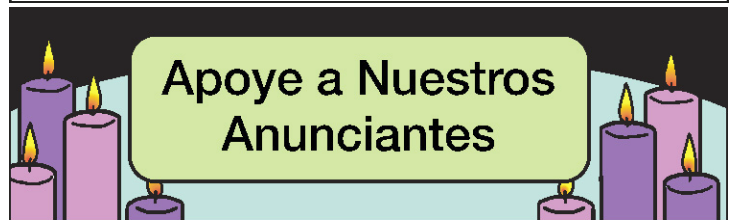
