Dear brothers and sisters,

On this fourth Sunday of Lent, we reflect on Jesus being our light in the midst of any darkness that may lie inside us or around us. This is called "Lætare" Sunday, which comes from the Latin translation of Is. 66:10-11 "Rejoice Jerusalem". We rejoice because Easter is coming near. There is reason to rejoice because Christ desires to bring light into our darkness. Our Gospel today gives us a dialogue between Jesus and the man born blind. This man is a beggar and some see him as underserving of Jesus' attention and touch. And yet Jesus sees him as a brother, one to heal and love. Jesus with compassion looks at this man and sees his heart.

The blind man in the gospel today represents the human race that was born blind before having faith in Christ, and before being enlightened by "the light of the world". This blind man grew in faith and in the knowledge of Christ in this long gospel passage. His faith matured through questions, trials and even suffering.

In our hearts we may be aware of our spiritual blindness, we know what is that obstacle or barrier within ourselves that block us from seeing clearly the work of God in our lives. This blind man opened his heart and trusted that Jesus could open his eyes to new light, to a new life and thus to salvation. This is God's invitation to us to continue our Lenten journey in the remaining weeks ahead and may all of us open our eyes and hearts to this process, to welcome the true light of Christ. Have a blessed week.

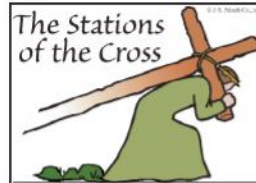

Cuarto Domingo de Cuaresma 31 de marzo de 2019

El que vive según Cristo es una creatura nueva; para él todo lo viejo ha pasado. Ya todo es nuevo. — 2 Corintios 5:17

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

En este cuarto domingo de Cuaresma, reflexionamos sobre Jesús como nuestra luz en medio de cualquier oscuridad que pueda estar dentro de nosotros o alrededor de nosotros. Este domingo se llama "Lætare", que proviene de la traducción latina de Isaías 66:10-11 "Alégrense con Jerusalén". Nos regocijamos porque se acerca la Pascua. Este ciego abrió su corazón y confió en que Jesús podría abrir sus ojos a una nueva luz, a una nueva vida y, por lo tanto, a la salvación. Esta es la invitación de Dios para que continuemos nuestro viaje de Cuaresma en las próximas semanas que nos quedan y que todos podamos abrir nuestros ojos y nuestro corazón a este proceso, para dar la bienvenida a la verdadera luz de Cristo. 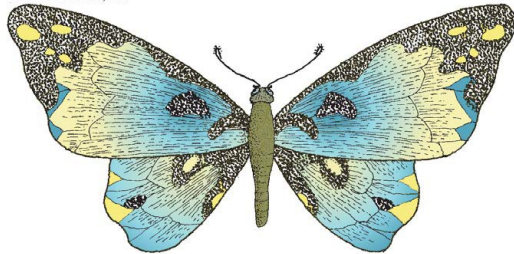
