

# Solemnity of All Saints



At the young age of seven, Carlo Acutis wrote, *"To be always united with Jesus, this is my life program."* Carlo Acutis was beatified on October 10, 2020 at the Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi in Italy. He died of leukemia at the young age of 15 in 2006. The young Italian computer whiz offered his suffering for the pope and the church and is now one step away from canonization.

Since he was a child, he had his gaze turned to Jesus. He felt a strong need to help people discover that God is close to us. Carlo once said, *"When we face the sun we get a tan...but when we stand before Jesus in the Eucharist we become saints."*

He was an ordinary boy, simple, spontaneous, likeable, loved nature and animals, he played football, had many friends his age, but was passionate about computer science. Being a computer whiz, who loved playing Super Mario and Pokemon, he also taught himself how to program and created websites cataloguing the world's Eucharistic miracles and Marian apparitions.

In Cardinal Vallini's homily at the beatification, he hailed Acutis as a model of how young people can use technology at the service of the Gospel to "reach as many people as possible and help them know the beauty of friendship with the Lord."

Thousands attended his beatification on October 10 and many people continue to come to visit Carlo's tomb asking for his blessing including many young people. They are coming for confessions because they want to change their lives and become closer to God.

Pope Francis declared that Carlo Acutis' feast will take place each year on October 12, the anniversary of his death.



## Solemnity of All Saints

November 1, 2020

**FOCUS:** We are all called to be saints.

Gathered at each Mass, we are like the crowd in today's Gospel, sitting at the feet of Jesus and seeking direction through his Word and spiritual nourishment through the Eucharist. Placing our hope in God and striving to lead virtuous lives, we look toward salvation and eternal life, and are reminded that we are all called to be saints.

**LITURGY OF THE WORD:** In the first reading, John relates his heavenly vision of salvation for God's chosen people. In the second reading, John writes that we are the children of God, and we have been called to place our hope in him. In the Gospel, Jesus preaches the Sermon on the Mount, reassuring his followers that the reward for those who live according to the new law will be great in heaven.




