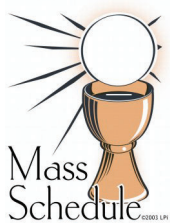

Fifth Sunday of Easter ~ May 15, 2022

FOCUS: Jesus commands us to love one another.

Jesus wants us to love as he loves. Our faithfulness and attentiveness to right and wrong, to holiness, and to the practice of faith is important. Yet Jesus furthers our understanding of following him by making clear the greatest commandment of every disciple: to love as he loves.

LITURGY OF THE WORD:

In the first reading, Paul and Barnabas continue their work and encourage the others to persevere in their faith. In the second reading, John describes his vision of a new heaven and a new earth where God dwells with his people and wipes the tears from their eyes: He proclaims, Behold, I make all things new. In the Gospel, Jesus gives his disciples a new commandment to love one another as he loves them.

REFLECTION:

That same Spirit that strengthened and brought new followers to the early church continues to "strengthen the spirits of the disciples" through spirit-filled preachers, teachers, musicians, lectors, parents, theologians etc.

So, we ask ourselves:

- Can you name a few Spirit-filled disciples in your worshipping community and give thanks to God at today's Eucharistic celebration for them?
- Would you personally thank them for the witness they give to presence of the Holy Spirit with the Church?

Are you willing to serve God and open to His plans for your life?
Do you have a life for prayer and the sacraments, especially the Eucharist?
Do you have a sense of joy and peace deep in your heart when you think about being a priest?

At a Mass of Ordination, those to be ordained are called forward after the Proclamation of the Gospel. This reminds us that the priesthood is, first and foremost, a calling. Look at the scriptures and reflect on what it means to be called by God.

The call of Moses ~ Read Exodus 3:1—4:17

Reflection: Every vocation is an 'exodus.' Like Moses, we are called to leave behind what we know and trust completely in God to show us the way to a whole new world.

Discern: Where am I in my life? What do I want to achieve? Am I prepared to place all my trust in God?



When 12-year-old Roneld St. Louis was growing up in South Haiti, a priest who was his teacher at the Good Shephard School told him, "I would like to see you as a young seminarian because I want you to carry my legacy."

The young man thought about this idea, and now, next Saturday, May 21, 2022, he will become the first Haitian-born man to be ordained a priest in the Archdiocese

of Philadelphia. As a new priest, Roneld hopes to focus on strengthening families, buoyed by his devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Newly ordained Father Roneld will then celebrate his first Mass at St. William Church on Sunday, May 22 at 1:30pm and everyone is invited to attend.

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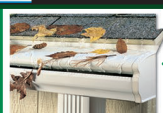
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
