**Did you know** The beloved hymn "Amazing Grace" was written by John Newton in late December 1772 as he was preparing for a New Year's Day sermon January 1, 1773? When John Newton, a former sea captain, wrote the lyrics of "Amazing Grace" for a sermon on New Year's Day 1773, he could see the "prodigal son" in his early life. His own father tried on several occasions to help him, but Newton was a hardened prodigal, a self-confessed "wretch" (a word he borrowed from Romans 7:24), distant from the heart of his father as well as the heart of God. Still, John Newton discovered that God in Christ's deep and abiding love does not give up on anyone.
