



JUNE 22, 2025 THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

The Pelican: A Symbol of Christ's Love in the Eucharist

In Catholic tradition, the image of the pelican feeding her young, in their nest, with her own blood has long been a symbol of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. Ancient legend said that, in times of need, a mother pelican would pierce her breast to nourish her chicks—giving her life so they might live. This beautiful image reminds us of the sacrificial love of Jesus, who offered His Body and Blood on the Cross, and who continues to feed us with that same Body and Blood in every Mass. The nest is most often seen as a symbol of Holy Mother Church, where the faithful (the chicks) are nourished by the sacrificial love of Christ (the pelican). Just as a nest is a place of protection, nurture, and growth, so too the Church is the spiritual home where Christians are cared for, taught, and fed—especially through the Eucharist. The Church has treasured this symbol for centuries. It appears in church art, on altars, and in sacred hymns—in our church, it's seen in the stained glass above the west side entrance. St. Thomas Aquinas wrote in *Adoro Te Devote*: "O loving Pelican, O Jesus Lord, cleanse me in Your Blood."

As we gaze upon the Eucharist, or receive Him in Holy Communion, may we remember: we are fed by the very life of Christ. He holds nothing back. And He invites us to do the same—to love, to give, to lay down our lives in return. Lord Jesus, Loving Pelican,

nourish me with Your life.

Make me a living gift for others.

Amen.
