**Thursday is the Mass of the Lord's Supper**

Palm Sunday begins Holy Week and leads to the Triduum, the most sacred time in the Church. On Holy Thursday, Catholics remember the Last Supper, when Jesus gave his disciples the Eucharist and showed them how to serve by washing their feet.

This Mass marks the end of Lent and the start of the three-day journey toward Easter. The readings from Palm Sunday remind people that Jesus willingly entered into suffering, and on Holy Thursday, he prepares for what is to come.

The Mass of the Lord's Supper is different from a regular Mass. The altar is stripped, and the Eucharist is placed in a special location for adoration. This recalls Jesus praying in the Garden of Gethsemane before his arrest.

Just as his disciples were called to stay with him, people today are invited to keep watch and reflect on his sacrifice. Holy Thursday sets the stage for the suffering and victory of Easter.
