**PASTOR'S NOTE**

PARISHIONERS, THE HOLY EUCHARIST BRINGS US TOGETHER IN SO MANY MARVELOUS WAYS FOR THIS SACRAMENT UNITES EVERYONE IN THE BODY, BLOOD, SOUL, AND DIVINITY OF CHRIST. WE ARE MADE PART OF CHRIST'S LIFE IN THE EUCHARIST. WE OFTEN THINK OF THIS AS JUST A PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP WITH CHRIST, BUT IT IS MORE THAN THIS AND INCLUDES NOT ONLY THE LIVING, BUT THE DEAD AS WELL. WE OFTEN CALL THE EUCHARIST HOLY COMMUNION. THE NAME MEANS THAT WE ARE UNITED WITH ONE ANOTHER: COM (WITH)-UNION. WE ARE ALSO UNITED WITH THE SAINTS IN HEAVEN AND THE SOULS IN PURGATORY. THE CHURCH CALLS THIS THE COMMUNION OF SAINTS. WHETHER WE ARE LIVING OR DEAD WE ARE ALL UNITED TOGETHER. THE COMMUNION OF SAINTS MEANS THOSE WHO ARE ALREADY SHARING ETERNAL BLISS WITH GOD. THIS IS THE CHURCH TRIUMPHANT, THEY HAVE MADE IT INTO HEAVEN. BUT THERE IS ALSO THE CHURCH SUFFERING. THEY HAVE DIED, BUT SOME STAIN OF SIN REMAINS ON THEIR SOUL. IF THEY WERE TO APPEAR BEFORE THE GLORY OF GOD WITH THIS STAIN THEIR SOULS WOULD BE IRREPARABLY HARMED. THEY HAVE THE HOPE THAT AT SOME POINT THEY WILL SHARE THE LOT OF THE SAINTS IN HEAVEN. WE, THE CHURCH MILITANT, ARE THE THIRD AND FINAL GROUP. WE ARE THE ONES WHO ARE NOW IN THAT STRUGGLE WITH EVIL AS WE STRIVE TO COME TO ETERNAL LIFE. SHARING IN THE COMMUNION OF SAINTS, WE CAN ALWAYS CALL UPON THEM FOR HELP IN OUR BATTLES TO COME TO ETERNAL BLISS AND WE CAN HELP THOSE IN PURGATORY THROUGH OUR PRAYERS AND ACTS OF CHARITY. UNITED TOGETHER IN CHRIST MEANS THAT WE HAVE EACH OTHER, WHETHER TOGETHER OR SEPARATED WHO CAN HELP US AND WHOM WE CAN HELP. WE SHARE THIS COMMON LIFE WHEN WE SHARE IN HOLY COMMUNION, THE EUCHARIST, WHICH UNITES US TOGETHER.
