Pensamientos del Padre Juan . . .

Gracia y Paz, mis hermanos y hermanas:

Los dos últimos días de nuestra peregrinación han sido el punto culminante de nuestro viaje a Inglaterra. El lunes condujimos hacia al sur, hasta Chichester, hasta la tumba de San Ricardo. En la tumba de San Ricardo celebramos misa y oramos por todos ustedes. En Chichester, fuimos testigos de la gran catedral que se encuentra en el centro de esta ciudad bastante pequeña. Como muchas catedrales, monasterios e iglesias construidas antes del reinado de Enrique VIII; la catedral de Chichester fue profanada. Durante la Reforma, muchas iglesias fueron destruidas y muchas tumbas de hombres y mujeres santos fueron profanadas con la esperanza de alejar a la gente de la fe católica. Actualmente, en la catedral de Chichester conserva una religuia de San Ricardo recuperada de Francia, donde estudió. Esta religuia se encuentra debajo del gran altar de la catedral. Esta gran catedral durante los siglos XVIII y XIX fue decorada con arte contemporáneo para resaltar la relación de las catedrales y el mecenazgo con los artistas. Los jardines de la catedral son los jardines más bellos de todas las iglesias que visitamos durante la peregrinación. Nuestra misa fue un momento conmovedor como peregrinos. Nos sentamos en esta pequeña pero acústica capilla en la que nuestro coro de peregrinos entonó diferentes himnos para acompañar la misa. Rezamos juntos la oración de San Ricardo y concluimos nuestra visita con un recorrido por el pueblo. Hubo lágrimas de alegría como peregrinos culminan su camino. Las gracias recibidas en este lugar santo regresan con nosotros a nuestra comunidad católica en Central Racine. Nos convertimos en "apóstoles" de San Ricardo en

Una perla escondida durante nuestra peregrinación fue nuestra visita a la Abadía de Westminster, donde está enterrado San Eduardo el Confesor. Para nuestra sorpresa, la tumba de Eduardo el Confesor sigue intacta desde la Edad Media. Eduardo que era rey y santo, los reformadores de la Iglesia de Inglaterra no tocaron la tumba de la abadía donde yacían otros reyes. Los restos de San Eduardo siguen intactos en la Abadía. Logramos organizar un recorrido privado por la tumba de San Eduardo, que está cerrada al público a menos que vaya con un guía de la Iglesia de Inglaterra. Allí nos sentamos los veinte alrededor de la tumba de San Eduardo y oramos nuevamente por todos nosotros. Después de eso, pasamos un buen rato visitando esta majestuosa abadía. Por supuesto, si no fuera por el tiempo de tranquilidad y oración alrededor de la tumba de San Eduardo, habría sido muy difícil orar en la Abadía. Cientos de personas vienen a visitar el famoso lugar donde se corona a los reves, y todos los dignatarios del reino se reúnen para este gran evento. Me pregunto si la gente allí sabía que estaban pisando tierra santa donde santos y personas de gran fe del pasado oraron y dieron sus vidas por los demás. Los veinte salimos renovados en nuestra fe. Concluimos la jornada con una misa en la iglesia de la Inmaculada Concepción de María.

Nos estamos preparando para volver y por supuesto, este domingo pasan muchas cosas. Este fin de semana haré la bendición de los catequistas de San Patricio. De esta manera nuestros catequistas recibirán una bendición al comenzar su jornada de enseñanza.

Thoughts from Father Juan . .

Grace and Peace, my brothers and sisters:

The last two days of our pilgrimage were the climax of our journey to England. Monday, we drove down south to Chichester, to the tomb of Saint Richard. At Saint Richard's tomb, we celebrated Mass and prayed for all of you. In Chichester, we witnessed the vast cathedral that stands in the center of this rather small city. As with many cathedrals, monasteries and churches built before Henry VIII's reign, the cathedral in Chichester was desecrated. During the Reformation many churches were destroyed, and a lot of tombs of holy men and women were desecrated in the hope of turning people away from the Catholic faith. Nowadays, in the Cathedral of Chichester, there is a relic of Saint Richard that was recovered from France, where he studied. This relic stands under the big altar in the cathedral. The small side chapel where he was buried after his death is now decorated with some statues. In the XIX and XX centuries this vast cathedral underwent major transformation with contemporary art to bring out the relationship of cathedrals and patronage to artists. The gardens of the cathedral are the most beautiful gardens of all the churches we visited during the pilgrimage. Our Mass was a moving moment as pilgrims. We sat down in this small but acoustically fine chapel, where our pilgrim choir chanted different hymns to accompany the Mass. We prayed together the prayer of Saint Richard and concluded our visit with a tour of the town. There were tears of joy as we pilgrims arrived at the end of the journey. The graces received in this holy site come back with us to our Catholic Community in Central Racine. We became "apostles" of Saint Richard to our communities.

A pearl hidden within our pilgrimage was our visit to Westminster Abbey, where Saint Edward the Confessor is buried. To our surprise, the tomb of Edward the Confessor has remained intact since the Middle Ages. Because Edward was a king and saint, and because the Church of England reformers did not touch the abbey's tomb where other kings lay, the remains of Saint Edward are still intact in the Abbey. We managed to arrange a private tour around the tomb of Saint Edward, which is closed to the public unless you are with a Church of England guide. There we sat down, the twenty of us, around Saint Edward's tomb and prayed again for all of us. After that, we spent a good amount of time visiting this majestic abbey. Of course, if it wasn't for the quiet and prayerful time around Saint Edward's tomb it would have been very difficult to pray in the Abbey. Hundreds of people come to visit the famous place where kings are crowned, and all the dignitaries of the realm gather for this great event. I wonder if people there knew that they were stepping on holy ground where saints and people of great faith of the past prayed and gave their lives for others. The twenty of us came out renewed in our faith. We concluded the day with a Mass in the Church of the Immaculate Conception of Mary.

We are getting ready to go back; and, of course, a few things are happening this Sunday, which is Catechetical Sunday. Some of our catechists will receive a blessing this Sunday, and others on the upcoming Sunday. At Saint Richard's José Mario will have the blessing of all catechists from Saint Edward's and Saint Richard's. I will do the blessing of Saint Patrick's catechists too this weekend. The following weekend, when I am at Sacred Heart, I will bless Sacred Heart's catechists. This way, between these two Sundays, all our catechists will receive a blessing as they begin their teaching journey in our Catholic Community in Central Racine: Family of Four Parishes.
