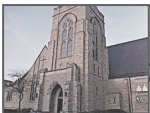

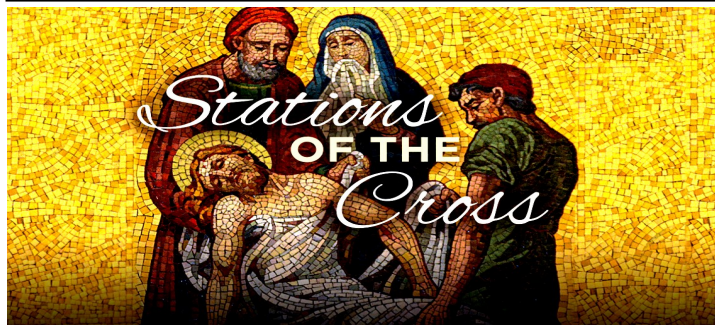

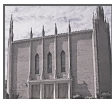

Pensamientos del Padre Juan . . .

Gracia y paz, mis hermanos y hermanas,

El tema de esta Cuaresma es **Cuaresma: un viaje hacia la renovación**. Me gustaría que cada domingo de Cuaresma recurramos a las Sagradas Escrituras y nos concentremos en un hábito específico para cambiar o desarrollar cada semana. Al reflexionar sobre la Palabra de Dios y comprometernos a realizar cambios positivos, podemos profundizar nuestra fe y acercarnos más a Cristo.

Primer domingo de Cuaresma: Tentación en el desierto (Lucas 4:1-13). El diablo tienta a Jesús en el desierto. Jesús supera cada tentación mediante una fe firme y la confianza en la Palabra de Dios. Hábito en el que trabajar: **Resistir la tentación**. Identifica una tentación o hábito específico que te aleje de Dios. Comprométete a resistir esta tentación mediante la oración, la lectura de las Sagradas Escrituras y la rendición de cuentas.

Segundo domingo de Cuaresma: La Transfiguración (Lucas 9:28b-36). Jesús se transfigura en la montaña, revelando su gloria divina a Pedro, Santiago y Juan. Hábito en el que trabajar: **Buscar la presencia de Dios**. Dedica tiempo cada día a experimentar la presencia de Dios a través de la oración, la meditación o la contemplación de la creación de Dios. Permítete ser transformado por su gloria.

Tercer domingo de Cuaresma: La higuera (Lucas 13:1-9). Jesús cuenta la parábola de la higuera estéril y enfatiza la importancia del arrepentimiento y de dar fruto. Hábito en el que trabajar: **Cultivar el crecimiento espiritual**. Identifica un área de tu vida espiritual que necesita crecimiento. Comprométete a nutrir esta área a través de prácticas como el estudio de la Biblia, asistir a misa o participar en un grupo pequeño.

Cuarto domingo de Cuaresma: El hijo pródigo (Lucas 15:1-3, 11-32). Jesús comparte la parábola del hijo pródigo, destacando los temas del arrepentimiento, el perdón y la misericordia ilimitada de Dios. Hábito en el que trabajar: **Practicar el perdón**. Reflexiona sobre cualquier rencor o falta de perdón que puedas tener. Haz un esfuerzo consciente por perdonar a los demás y buscar la reconciliación cuando sea necesario.

Quinto Domingo de Cuaresma: La mujer sorprendida en adulterio (Juan 8:1-11). Jesús perdona a la mujer sorprendida en adulterio y la anima a "vete y no peques más". Hábito en el que trabajar: Extender gracia y compasión. Concéntrate en extender gracia y compasión a los demás, especialmente a aquellos que pueden haberle hecho daño. Recuerde que todos somos receptores de la misericordia de Dios y estamos llamados a compartirla con los demás.

Domingo de Ramos de la Pasión del Señor (Lucas 19:28-40; 22:14—23:56). La entrada triunfal de Jesús en Jerusalén, seguida de su Pasión y Crucifixión. Hábito en el que trabajar: **Abrazar el sacrificio**. Reflexione sobre los sacrificios que Jesús hizo por nosotros. Identifique formas en las que puede sacrificar su tiempo, recursos o comodidades para servir a los demás y profundizar su relación con Cristo.

Mientras transitamos la Cuaresma con el tema de la renovación, hagamos intencionalmente cambios positivos en nuestras vidas. Si nos centramos en un hábito específico cada semana y nos fortalecemos con las Sagradas Escrituras, podemos crecer en nuestra fe y convertirnos en discípulos misioneros del Señor. Hagamos de esta Cuaresma un tiempo sagrado de renovación para todos nosotros.

Thoughts from Father Juan . . .

Grace and Peace, my brothers and sisters,

The theme for this Lent is **Lent: A Journey to Renewal**. I would like us to draw from the Scriptures for each Sunday of Lent and focus on a specific habit to change or develop each week. By reflecting on the Word of God and committing to positive changes, we can deepen our faith and draw closer to Christ.

First Sunday of Lent: Temptation in the Wilderness (Luke 4:1-13). The devil tempts Jesus in the wilderness. Jesus overcomes each temptation through steadfast faith and reliance on God's Word. Habit to work on: **Resist Temptation**. Identify a specific temptation or habit that leads you away from God. Commit to resisting this temptation through prayer, scripture reading, and accountability.

Second Sunday of Lent: The Transfiguration (Luke 9:28b- 36). Jesus is transfigured on the mountain, revealing his divine glory to Peter, James, and John. Habit to work on: **Seek God's Presence**. Dedicate time each day to experience God's presence through prayer, meditation, or contemplation of God's creation. Allow yourself to be transformed by his glory.

Third Sunday of Lent: The Fig Tree (Luke 13:1-9). Jesus tells the parable of the barren fig tree and emphasizes the importance of repentance and bearing fruit. Habit to work on: **Cultivate Spiritual Growth**. Identify an area of your spiritual life that needs growth. Commit to nurturing this area through practices like Bible study, attending Mass, or participating in a small group.

Fourth Sunday of Lent: The Prodigal Son (Luke 15:1-3, 11-32). Jesus shares the parable of the prodigal son, highlighting the themes of repentance, forgiveness, and God's boundless mercy. Habit to work on: **Practice Forgiveness**. Reflect on any grudges or unforgiveness you may be holding onto. Make a conscious effort to forgive others and seek reconciliation where needed.

Fifth Sunday of Lent: The Woman Caught in Adultery (John 8:1-11). Jesus forgives the woman caught in adultery and encourages her to "go and sin no more." Habit to work on: **Extend Grace and Compassion**. Focus on extending grace and compassion to others, especially those who may have wronged you. Remember that we are all recipients of God's mercy and are called to share it with others.

Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion (Luke 19:28-40; 22:14—23:56). Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem, followed by his Passion and Crucifixion. Habit to work on: **Embrace Sacrifice**. Reflect on the sacrifices Jesus made for us. Identify ways you can sacrifice your time, resources, or comforts to serve others and deepen your relationship with Christ.

As we journey through Lent with the theme of renewal, let us intentionally make positive changes in our lives. By focusing on a specific habit each week and drawing strength from the Scriptures, we can grow in our faith and become missionary disciples of the Lord. Let us make this Lenten season a holy season of renewal for all of us.
