## Pensamientos del Padre Juan . . .

Gracia y paz a ustedes, mis hermanos y hermanas. Este fin de semana celebramos la Solemnidad del Corpus Christi, también conocida como la Fiesta del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo. Es una profunda celebración de la presencia real de Jesucristo en la Eucaristía. Instituida en el siglo XIII, esta fiesta nos invita a detenemos y reflexionar sobre el misterio y el milagro que se realiza en cada misa: Cristo verdaderamente presente, Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad, bajo la apariencia de pan y vino.

Cada vez que celebramos esta solemnidad, me trae grandes recuerdos de mi infancia y de mi difunto abuelo. En mi pueblo natal, había una procesión por el pueblo y se traían diferentes ofrendas para celebrar esta importante fiesta. Mi abuelo dedicaba unas semanas antes de esta solemnidad a preparar las ofrendas que recibiría para ofrecer al Señor ese día. Principalmente, sus ofrendas provenían de su granja y de su afición sagrada, la caza. Cazaba varios animales y los traía como ofrenda. Normalmente, la gente compraba todo eso, y luego la parroquia recibía el dinero de las generosas ofrendas que traían ese día. Mientras la procesión con el Santísimo Sacramento recorría el pueblo y la plaza principal, donde todos habían depositado sus ofrendas, Cristo las bendecía. Fue un momento maravilloso y profundo de fe y devoción al Señor. El día estuvo impregnado de un sentido de reverencia y misterio.

Ahora que soy mayor, con todos nuestros avances tecnológicos, parece que vivimos en un mundo que a menudo busca pruebas tangibles y señales visibles; un mundo que quiere deshacerse del misterio y la belleza de lo desconocido. Al igual que la Santísima Trinidad, el Corpus Christi es un misterio al que nos acercamos con asombro, amor y reverencia. Así como la Santísima Trinidad es un gran signo de unidad y comunión, la Eucaristía es un testimonio silencioso y poderoso de nuestra fe. Me encanta que estemos haciendo procesiones en todas nuestras parroquias este año. Esto me recuerda a mi infancia y es un maravilloso testimonio de nuestra presencia católica en nuestra ciudad. Recorremos las calles de nuestros barrios rezando para que la presencia de Cristo traiga bendiciones a quienes nos rodean.

Corpus Christi es un misterio que trasciende la comprensión humana, pero también es profundamente personal e íntimo. Cada vez que recibimos la Eucaristía, nos unimos a Cristo y a los demás en una comunión que nutre nuestras almas y nuestra misión como discípulos. Corpus Christi es una celebración de la presencia de Cristo y un llamado a convertirnos en lo que recibimos. San Agustín dijo una vez: «Contempla lo que eres, conviértete en lo que recibes». La Eucaristía nos transforma en el Cuerpo de Cristo en el mundo, llamados a servir, amar y dar esperanza a los demás.

Esta fiesta también nos recuerda la importancia de la reverencia y la gratitud. ¿Con qué frecuencia nos acercamos al altar de forma rutinaria en lugar de con asombro? Corpus Christi nos invita a renovar nuestra devoción, a adorar a Cristo en el Santísimo Sacramento y a permitir que su presencia moldee nuestras vidas. Al celebrar esta solemnidad, que nos sumerjamos más profundamente en el misterio de la Eucaristía y renovemos nuestro compromiso de vivir como fieles testigos del amor de Cristo en el mundo.

Los invito a unirse a una de nuestras procesiones. Mientras caminan con Cristo, oremos por nuestras familias, nuestra comunidad, nuestra ciudad y el mundo, pidiendo al Señor que traiga paz y armonía a nuestras vidas.

## Thoughts from Father Juan . . .

Grace and Peace to you, my brothers and sisters,

This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, also known as the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. This is a profound celebration of the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. Instituted in the 13th century, this feast invites us to pause and reflect on the mystery and miracle that takes place at every Mass: Christ truly present, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity, under the appearance of bread and wine.

Every time we celebrate this solemnity, it brings great memories from my childhood and late grandfather. In my hometown, there was a procession around the town, and different offerings were brought to celebrate this important feast. My grandfather would spend a few weeks before this solemnity preparing the gifts he would get to offer the Lord on this day. Mostly, his gifts came from his farm and his sacred hobby, hunting. He would catch several animals and bring them to present as an offering. Usually, people would buy all that, and then the parish would get the cash from all the great gifts people brought that day. As the procession with the Blessed Sacrament went around the town and the main square where all the people had placed their offerings, Christ would bless them. It was a wonderful and profound moment of faith and devotion to the Lord. The day was imbued with a sense of reverence and mystery.

Now that I am older, with all our technological advances, we seem to live in a world that often seeks tangible proof and visible signs--a world that wants to be rid of the mystery and the beauty of the unknown. Just like the Most Holy Trinity, Corpus Christi is a mystery we approach with awe, love, and reverence. Just as the Most Holy Trinity is a great sign of unity and communion, the Eucharist is a quiet, powerful testimony of our faith. I love that we are doing processions in all our parishes this year. This brings me back to my childhood and is a marvelous testimony of our Catholic presence in our city. We walk the streets of our neighborhoods praying that Christ's presence brings blessings to those we encounter.

Corpus Christi is a mystery transcending human understanding, yet it is also deeply personal and intimate. Each time we receive the Eucharist, we are united with Christ and one another in a communion that nourishes our souls and our mission as disciples. Corpus Christi is a celebration of Christ's presence and a call to become what we receive. Saint Augustine once said, "Behold what you are, become what you receive." The Eucharist transforms us into the Body of Christ in the world, called to serve, love, and bring hope to others.

This feast also reminds us of the importance of reverence and gratitude. How often do we approach the altar in a routine fashion rather than with awe? Corpus Christi invites us to renew our devotion, to adore Christ in the Blessed Sacrament, and to allow his presence to shape our lives. As we celebrate this solemnity, may we be drawn deeper into the mystery of the Eucharist and recommit ourselves to living as faithful witnesses of Christ's love in the world.

I invite you to join one of our processions. As you walk with Christ, let us pray for our families, community, city, and world, asking the Lord to bring peace and harmony to our lives.
