

Pensamientos del Padre Juan . . .

Gracia y paz a ustedes, mis hermanos y hermanas. En el Evangelio de este domingo, Jesús ofrece una enseñanza aleccionadora y poderosa: «Esfuércense por entrar por la puerta estrecha». Es un llamado al discipulado intencional, no a la mera asociación. La pregunta que se le plantea a Jesús: «Señor, ¿se salvarán solo unos pocos?», no se responde con números, sino con un desafío: la salvación no es automática; requiere esfuerzo, humildad y un corazón sincero. Requiere un camino comprometido de discipulado, siguiendo al Señor de cerca y con todo el corazón.

La puerta estrecha no se trata de exclusión, sino de transformación. Nos invita a despojarnos del orgullo, la complacencia y la fe superficial. Jesús advierte que muchos afirmarán tener familiaridad con él — «Comimos y bebimos contigo»—, pero serán rechazados porque no vivieron el Evangelio en verdad. Esto es lo que significa el discipulado intencional. No se trata solo de identificarse con Jesús, sino de esforzarse por actuar como un discípulo fiel que vive la compasión, la misericordia, la generosidad, el perdón y el amor. La tentación es vivir una vida tibia en Cristo. Nos asociamos con él, pero no lo seguimos plenamente. Nos convertimos en cristianos solo de nombre, pero no en hechos. El Evangelio de Cristo es práctico y exige trabajo duro diario.

Este pasaje nos recuerda que estar cerca de Jesús significa más que proximidad; implica participación. Significa permitir que su Palabra moldee nuestras vidas, nuestras decisiones y nuestras relaciones. La puerta es estrecha, no porque Dios sea tacaño con la gracia, sino porque el amor exige compromiso.

Los invito a orar con estas preguntas esta semana: ¿Estoy realmente esforzándome por seguir a Cristo o simplemente estoy actuando por inercia? ¿Qué áreas de mi vida necesitan una conversión más profunda? ¿Cómo puedo ayudar a otros a encontrar y cruzar la puerta estrecha?

Estas preguntas nos invitan a reflexionar más profundamente sobre cómo seguir al Señor con valentía y alegría, confiando en que el camino angosto conduce a la plenitud de la vida en él.

Thoughts from Father Juan . . .

Grace and Peace to you, my brothers and sisters,

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus offers a sobering and powerful teaching: "Strive to enter through the narrow door." It's a call to intentional discipleship, not mere association. The question posed to Jesus: "Lord, will only a few be saved?" is met not with numbers, but with a challenge: salvation is not automatic; it requires effort, humility, and a sincere heart. It requires a committed journey of discipleship following the Lord closely and with a whole heart.

The narrow door is not about exclusion, but about transformation. It invites us to shed pride, complacency, and superficial faith. Jesus warns that many will claim familiarity with him -- "We ate and drank in your company" -- but will be turned away because they failed to live the Gospel in truth. This is what intentional discipleship means. It is not only to identify with Jesus but to strive to act as a faithful disciple living out compassion, mercy, generosity, forgiveness, and love. The temptation is to live a lukewarm life in Christ. We associate with him but don't follow him fully. We become "Christians" in name only but not in actions. The Gospel of Christ is actionable and demands hard work daily.

This passage reminds us that being close to Jesus means more than proximity; it implies participation. It means allowing his Word to shape our lives, our choices, and our relationships. The door is narrow, not because God is stingy with grace, but because love demands commitment.

I invite you to pray with these questions this week: Am I truly striving to follow Christ, or merely going through the motions? What areas of my life need more profound conversion? How can I help others find and walk through the narrow door?

These questions invite us to reflect deeper on following the Lord with courage and joy, trusting that the narrow path leads to the fullness of life in him.
