### Pensamientos del Padre Juan . . .

Gracia y paz a ustedes, mis hermanos y hermanas.

El Evangelio de este domingo presenta la parábola del **mayordomo deshonesto**. Cada vez que se menciona este pasaje, la historia me desconcierta. Supongamos que lo leen sin mucha atención ni reflexión. La historia parece elogiar la mala conducta. El mayordomo, ante el despido, actúa astutamente reduciendo las deudas de los deudores de su amo, con la esperanza de asegurarse el favor y un futuro entre ellos. Sorprendentemente, Jesús elogia su prudencia, no su deshonestidad, sino su capacidad para actuar con decisión en un momento de crisis. Creo que la frase clave para entender la parábola es esta: **«Porque los hijos de este mundo son más prudentes al tratar con su propia generación que los hijos de la luz».**

Esta parábola no es una lección de astucia financiera, sino **una llamada de atención espiritual**. Jesús contrasta la sabiduría mundana del mayordomo con la negligencia espiritual de «los hijos de la luz». Es decir, sus discípulos y seguidores. En esta época, así somos nosotros, hermanos y hermanas. Somos hijos de la luz de Cristo, compartida a través de nuestro bautismo. Jesús nos reta a reflexionar: ¿Nos preocupamos tanto por nuestro bienestar eterno como por nuestras necesidades materiales y sociales? ¿Es el cuidado de nuestras almas tan crucial? A veces, parecemos estar más preocupados por las cosas mundanas que por nuestras propias almas. Por eso Jesús pone el ejemplo del administrador deshonesto, porque cuando nos vemos presionados y acorralados, nos volvemos creativos y solucionamos nuestras necesidades físicas y sociales. ¿Prestamos la misma atención a los asuntos de nuestras almas?

La urgencia del administrador por asegurar su futuro nos invita a considerar nuestras propias prioridades. A menudo invertimos mucha energía en asegurar la comodidad, la reputación y el éxito, pero descuidamos las necesidades más profundas del alma. Jesús nos llama a ser **sabios administradores de la gracia**, atentos a las consecuencias eternas de nuestras decisiones. Ser espiritualmente sabio significa vivir con **la eternidad en mente**. Significa cultivar una vida de oración, integridad y caridad. Significa ser honestos con nosotros mismos y con Dios, reconocer dónde hemos malgastado los dones que se nos han confiado—nuestro tiempo, nuestras relaciones y nuestros recursos— y buscar la reconciliación.

Jesús concluye con una verdad cruda: **«No se puede servir a Dios y a las riquezas».** Esto no es solo una advertencia contra la avaricia, sino un llamado a **elegir a nuestro amo**. ¿Serviremos a las comodidades efímeras de este mundo o a la verdad eterna de Dios?

El administrador actuó para asegurar su bienestar físico y social. Se nos invita a actuar con mayor urgencia para asegurar **nuestro bienestar espiritual**. Si mañana lo perdiéramos todo, ¿qué nos quedaría? ¿Hemos construido una vida arraigada en la fe, el amor y la confianza en Dios? Este Evangelio nos invita a vivir con sabiduría, sin temor. Seamos administradores prudentes, no de las riquezas, sino de la gracia. Invirtamos en lo que realmente perdura y vivamos cada día con la claridad y la valentía que nos da saber que nuestro verdadero hogar está en Dios.

# St. Edward, St. Patrick, and St. Richard Parishes

## Thoughts from Father Juan . . .

Grace and Peace to you, my brothers and sisters,

This Sunday's Gospel presents the parable of the **dishonest steward**. Every time this passage comes up, I am puzzled by the story. Suppose you read it without great attention and prayerful reflection. The story seems to praise wrongful behavior. The steward, facing dismissal, acts shrewdly by reducing the debts of his master's debtors, hoping to secure favor and a future among them. Surprisingly, Jesus praises his prudence, not his dishonesty, but his ability to act decisively in a moment of crisis. I think the key phrase to understand the parable is this: **"For the children of this world are more prudent in dealing with their own generation than are the children of light."**

This parable is not a lesson in financial cunning, but a **spiritual wake-up call**. Jesus contrasts the steward's worldly wisdom with the spiritual negligence of "the children of light." This means his disciples and followers. In this age, this is us, my brothers and sisters. We are the children of the light of Christ shared through our baptism. Jesus challenges us to reflect: Are we as concerned about our eternal well-being as we are about our material and social needs? Is the care of our souls as critical? At times, we seem to be more concerned with the "worldly stuff" than with our own souls. That's why Jesus brings the example of the dishonest steward, because when we are pressed and cornered, we get creative and solve our physical and social needs. Do we pay the same attention to the matters of our souls?

The steward's urgency in securing his future invites us to consider our own priorities. We often invest significant energy in ensuring comfort, reputation, and success, yet neglect the deeper needs of the soul. Jesus calls us to be **wise stewards of grace**, attentive to the eternal consequences of our choices. To be spiritually wise means living with **eternity in mind**. It means cultivating a life of prayer, integrity, and charity. It means being honest with ourselves and with God, recognizing where we have mismanaged the gifts entrusted to us--our time, relationships, and resources--and seeking reconciliation.

Jesus concludes with a stark truth: **"You cannot serve both God and mammon."** This is not merely a warning against greed, but a call to **choose our master**. Will we serve the fleeting comforts of this world, or will we serve the eternal truth of God?

The steward acted to secure his physical and social well-being. We are invited to act with even greater urgency to ensure our **spiritual well-being**. If we were to lose everything tomorrow, what would remain? Have we built a life rooted in faith, love, and trust in God? This Gospel invites us to live wisely, not fearfully. Let us be prudent stewards, not of wealth, but of grace. Let us invest in what truly lasts and live each day with the clarity and courage that come from knowing our true home is in God.
