### Pensamientos del Padre Juan . . .

Gracia y paz, mis hermanos y hermanas,

La Fiesta de la Dedicación de la **Basílica de Letrán** en Roma se celebra anualmente el 9 de noviembre y tiene un profundo significado para los católicos de todo el mundo. Si bien conmemora la consagración de un edificio específico, la **Archibasílica de San Juan de Letrán**, catedral del Obispo de Roma, es mucho más que una fiesta romana. Es una celebración universal de **la unidad y la comunión** de la Iglesia.

La Basílica de Letrán es **la madre y cabeza de todas las iglesias en Roma y en el mundo**. Como catedral del Papa, simboliza su autoridad pastoral y la unidad de la Iglesia bajo su liderazgo. Su dedicación recuerda a los fieles que la Iglesia no es simplemente un conjunto de edificios, sino **un templo vivo de creyentes**, edificado sobre el fundamento de los apóstoles, con Cristo como piedra angular. Esta profunda realidad de ser templo vivo del Espíritu Santo nos impacta profundamente en nuestras vidas. Desde que aprendí este concepto en los escritos de San Pablo, me ha fascinado cómo puedo ponerlo en práctica. Piensa por un momento en ti como un templo viviente del Espíritu Santo. ¿Qué tendrías que cambiar en tu vida para vivir plenamente este llamado?

Esta fiesta invita a reflexionar sobre **el significado espiritual de la Iglesia como el Cuerpo de Cristo**, esta hermosa imagen que Pablo compartió con nosotros en la Carta a los Corintios. La estructura física de la Basílica de Letrán apunta a la realidad más profunda de la Iglesia como comunidad de creyentes, llamados a la santidad y la unidad. Las lecturas de esta fiesta resaltan la sacralidad de la Iglesia y el llamado a la santidad. Si somos el Cuerpo de Cristo, la Iglesia, entonces nuestro bautismo nos impulsa a esforzarnos por vivir en santidad y a llevar la unidad a todo el pueblo de Dios.

Vivimos en tiempos difíciles, en un mundo dividido; estas divisiones y tensiones también pueden surgir dentro de la Iglesia. Esta fiesta es un poderoso recordatorio de **nuestra identidad y misión compartidas**. Llama a todos los católicos, ya sea en Roma o en cualquier otro rincón del mundo, a renovar su compromiso con la unidad en la fe, la liturgia y la caridad. La Basílica de Letrán se erige como un signo visible de **la continuidad apostólica de la Iglesia**, arraigada en el ministerio de Pedro y sus sucesores.

En definitiva, la Fiesta de la Dedicación de la Basílica de Letrán es una celebración de la Iglesia como **hogar espiritual** para todos, lugar de encuentro con Dios y comunidad de amor y verdad. Nos invita a ser **piedras vivas** en la Iglesia, unidos en Cristo y comprometidos con la edificación del Cuerpo de Cristo en el mundo. Esta semana, les invito a preguntarse: ¿Cómo contribuyo al crecimiento del Cuerpo de Cristo en este mundo? ¿Qué debo hacer para ser testigo de la unidad y la comunión dentro de la Iglesia?

## Thoughts from Father Juan . . .

Grace and Peace, my brothers and sisters,

The Feast of the Dedication of the **Lateran Basilica** in Rome is celebrated annually on November 9 and holds profound significance for Catholics worldwide. Though it commemorates the consecration of a specific building, the **Archbasilica of St. John Lateran**, the cathedral of the Bishop of Rome, it is much more than a local Roman feast. It is a universal celebration of the **unity and communion** of the Church.

The Lateran Basilica is the **mother and head of all churches in Rome and the world**. As the cathedral of the Pope, it symbolizes his pastoral authority and the unity of the Church under his leadership. Its dedication reminds the faithful that the Church is not merely a collection of buildings, but a **living temple of believers**, built upon the foundation of the apostles, with Christ as the cornerstone. This profound reality of us as the living temple for the Holy Spirit impacts us deeply in our lives. Ever since I learned this concept from Saint Paul's writings, I have been fascinated by how I can bring it to life. Think for a moment of you as a living temple of the Holy Spirit. What would need to change in your life to live this call fully?

This feast encourages reflection on the **spiritual significance of the Church as the Body of Christ**, this beautiful image that Paul shared with us in the Letter to the Corinthians. The physical structure of the Lateran Basilica points to the deeper reality of the Church as a community of believers, called to be holy and united. The readings for this feast highlight the sacredness of the Church and the call to holiness. If we are the Body of Christ, the Church, then we are all compelled by our baptism to strive to live in holiness and to bring unity to all God's people.

We live in today's challenging times, a divided world; these divisions and tensions can also arise within the Church. This feast is a powerful reminder of our **shared identity and mission**. It calls all Catholics, whether in Rome or in any other corner of the world, to renew their commitment to unity in faith, worship, and charity. The Lateran Basilica stands as a visible sign of the Church's **apostolic continuity**, rooted in the ministry of Peter and his successors.

Ultimately, the Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica is a celebration of the Church as a **spiritual home** for all people, a place of encounter with God, and a community of love and truth. It challenges us to be **living stones** in the Church, united in Christ, and committed to building up the Body of Christ in the world. This week, I invite you to ask yourself: How am I contributing to the growth of the Body of Christ in this world? What should I do to be a witness to unity and communion within the Church?
