### Pensamientos del Padre Juan . . .

Gracia y paz a ustedes, mis hermanos y hermanas. El domingo pasado, con el Bautismo del Señor, concluimos las celebraciones que comenzamos en Navidad. En el Bautismo del Señor, se cumple toda la manifestación de Jesús como Hijo de Dios, que comienza con su Encarnación en Navidad. Este fin de semana, la Iglesia nos invita a continuar nuestro camino en el Tiempo Ordinario. En el Evangelio de hoy, Juan el Bautista hace una poderosa declaración: «He aquí el Cordero de Dios, que quita el pecado del mundo». Con estas palabras, Juan identifica a Jesús como el Mesías tan esperado e invita a sus propios discípulos a reconocer a Jesús como Aquel que cumple las promesas de Dios. Juan comprendió completamente su misión: preparar el camino y reconocer a Jesús cuando llegó al Jordán. Su testimonio ayudó a muchos a creer y a comenzar a seguir a Jesús. Al igual que Juan, también estamos llamados a reconocer al Señor en nuestras vidas y a señalarlo a los demás. Ojalá nuestras acciones ayuden a muchos a seguir al Señor.

Este momento es más que una introducción; es un llamado al **discipulado**. Los propios discípulos de Juan escucharon su testimonio y comenzaron a seguir a Jesús. Su decisión nos recuerda que la fe no es pasiva; requiere una respuesta. Seguir a Cristo significa dejar atrás las zonas de confort y abrazar un compromiso intencional. Al comenzar este nuevo año, la Iglesia nos invita a reflexionar sobre: ¿Quién es Jesús para mí hoy? ¿Qué tan profunda es mi relación con Él? ¿Estoy preparado para seguirlo más de cerca este año? ¿Qué debo dejar atrás para avanzar con el Señor?

El discipulado es un acto deliberado, no algo que sucede por casualidad. Implica decisiones intencionales que reflejan el Evangelio en nuestras vidas, como priorizar la oración, participar en los sacramentos, servir a los demás y dar testimonio de Cristo en la vida cotidiana. Al igual que Juan, nuestras vidas deben ser un testimonio de Cristo para los demás.

Los invito esta semana a profundizar su compromiso con Cristo. Oren por la gracia de verlo como el Cordero de Dios que quita todos nuestros pecados y de seguirlo plenamente. **El discipulado comienza con una elección: ¿la harán esta semana?**

El próximo fin de semana es el Domingo de la Palabra de Dios, una hermosa conmemoración que nos recuerda que Dios nos habla a través de su Palabra. Celebraremos este fin de semana con una Conferencia Bíblica centrada en el Evangelio de Mateo, especialmente en el llamado profético al discipulado. La conferencia, con la participación del Dr. Dan Scholz, se llevará a cabo en el salón Haban de Sacred Heart el sábado por la mañana, 24 de enero, a partir de las 9:00. Espero verlos allí. ## Thoughts from Father Juan . . .

Grace and Peace to you, my brothers and sisters.

Last Sunday, with the Baptism of the Lord, we concluded the celebrations we began at Christmas. In the Baptism of the Lord, the whole manifestation of Jesus as the Son of God, which begins by his Incarnation at Christmas, is fulfilled. This weekend, the Church invites us to continue our journey in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel, John the Baptist makes a powerful declaration: "Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world." With these words, John identifies Jesus as the long-awaited Messiah and invites his own disciples to recognize Jesus as the One who fulfills God's promises. John understood his mission completely: to prepare the way and to recognize Jesus as he came to the Jordan. His testimony helped many to believe and to begin following Jesus. Like John, we are also called to recognize the Lord in our lives and to point others to him. Hopefully, our actions will help many to follow the Lord.

This moment is more than an introduction; it is a call to **discipleship**. John's own disciples heard his testimony and began to follow Jesus. Their decision reminds us that faith is not passive; it requires a response. To follow Christ means leaving behind comfort zones and embracing an intentional commitment. As we start this new year, the Church invites us to reflect on: Who is Jesus to me today? How deep is my relationship with him? Am I prepared to follow him more closely this year? What must I leave behind to go forward with the Lord?

Discipleship is a deliberate act, not something that happens by chance. It involves intentional choices that reflect the Gospel in our lives, such as prioritizing prayer, engaging in the sacraments, serving others, and witnessing to Christ in everyday life. Like John, our lives must be a testimony for Christ to others.

I invite you this week to deepen your commitment to Christ. Pray for the grace to see him as the Lamb of God who takes away all our sins and to follow him fully. **Discipleship starts with a choice—will you make it this week?**

Next weekend is Word of God Sunday, a beautiful commemoration that reminds us that God speaks to us through his Word. We will observe this weekend with a Scripture Conference focusing on the Gospel of Matthew, especially the Prophetic call to discipleship. The conference, featuring Dr. Dan Scholz, will be held in Haban Hall at Sacred Heart, on Saturday morning, January 24, starting at 9:00. I hope to see you there.
