the tags carefully, one charity has requested specific instructions (no gift wrap, no gift bags, no ribbons, no batteries and no candy).

We request that the gifts be returned anytime, but no later than Sunday, November 27th.

Here are the guidelines to help in the distribution process:

- ♦ If YOU TAKE A TAG, PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT YOU RETURN A GIFT FOR THE REQUEST.
- ♦ If you take a tag requesting a gift, please wrap the gift and return it with the **original tag attached**. This identifies who will receive the gift and is very important to assist in the distribution.
- ♦ GIFT CARD REQUESTS: PLEASE DO NOT WRAP GIFT CARDS. PLACE THEM IN AN UNSEALED ENVELOPE WITH THE ORIGINAL GIFT TAG ATTACHED. The agencies that distribute the gifts need to know the dollar value of each certificate in order to make an equitable distribution among the families. If you have sealed the envelope, please put the dollar value on the front of the envelope (IN PENCIL). Also, please be sure the gift card is activated by the store at the time of purchase.
- ♦ Gift receipts are advisable with clothing items should an exchange be necessary.
- ♦ A GIFT CARD MAY BE SUBSTITUTED FOR ANY GIFT IF YOU ARE HAVING DIFFICULTY FILLING A SPECIFIC REQUEST.

We look forward to the St. Anne Parish annual works of charity and hope that once again we will bring Christmas joy and happiness to the many families that will benefit from our help. Thank you to everyone who will support this endeavor.

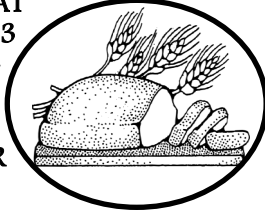
