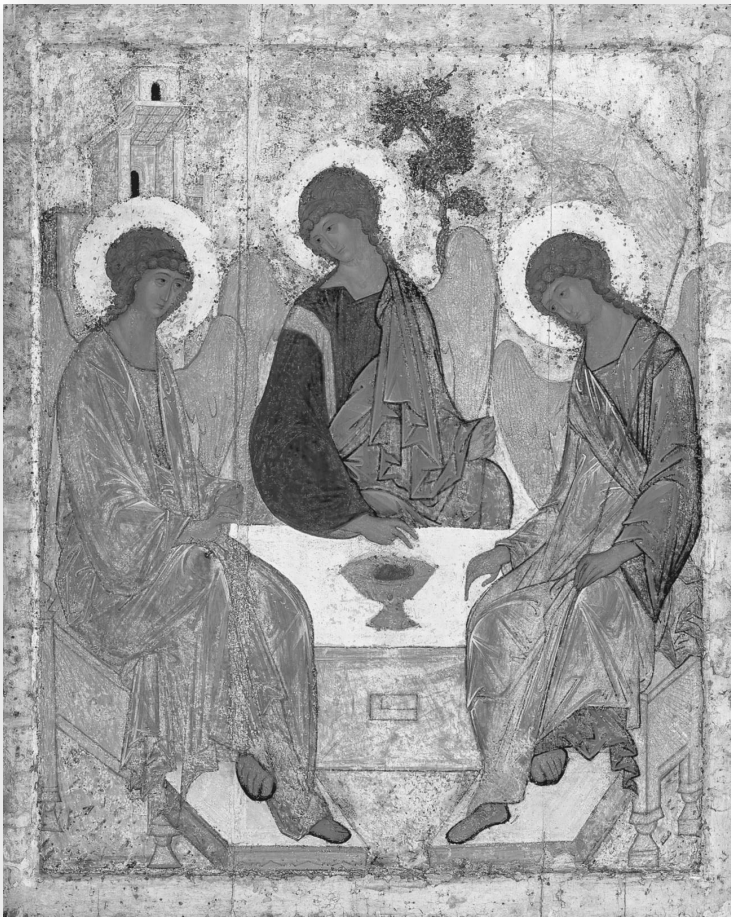
Sacrament of Baptism

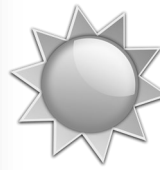
The Trinity, Icon by Andrei Rublev, 15th Century

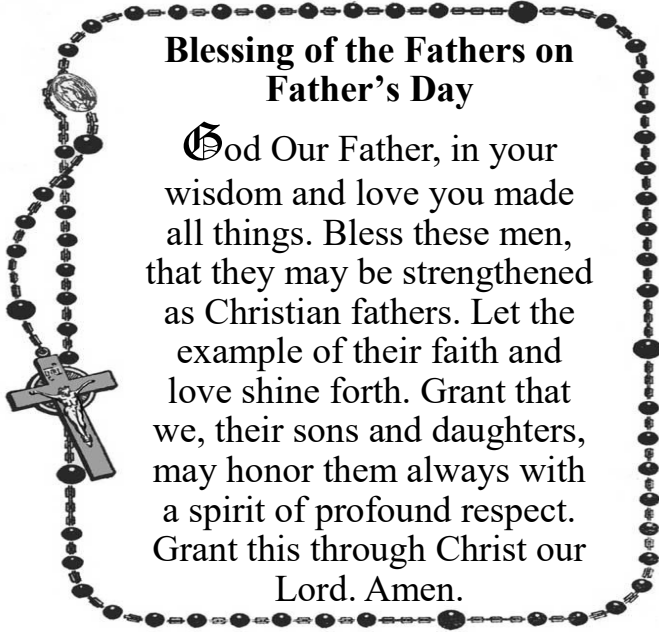
