Information for Catholic Religious Emblems for Scouting

Scouting provides many opportunities for Duty to God, the most extensive of which are the religious emblem programs for ALL faiths. Religious emblem programs are overseen by the Worcester Diocese Catholic Committee on Scouting (DCCS). At the Pack level there are two Catholic religious emblems which can be earned with guidance from the parents and local parish priest. At the Troop level there are two additional Catholic religious emblems which can be earned under the guidance of certified religious emblem instructors. The pinnacle Catholic religious emblem to be earned is the Pillars of Faith award for a Scout who has earned all four Scouting Catholic religious emblems. It is rarer than the Eagle Award.
