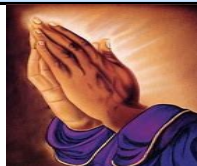

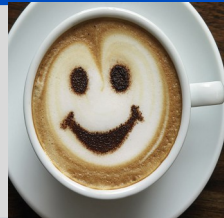

FOOD TRUCK FESTIVAL 2025

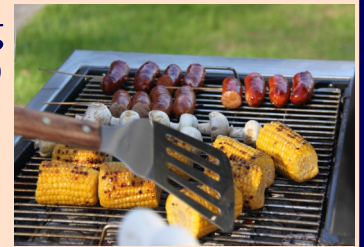
The Rotary Club of Southborough is once
