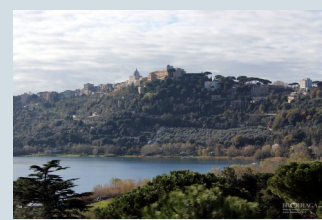

POPE LEO XIV— SUMMER VACATION TIME!

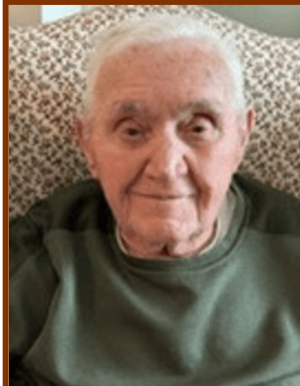
