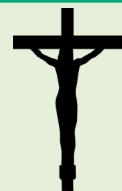


### The Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

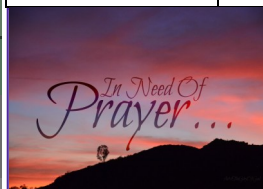

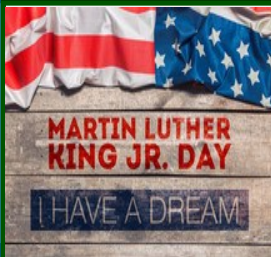
## RIDES TO MASS?
