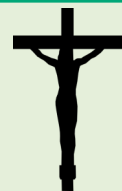
Second Sunday of Easter-Sunday of Divine Mercy

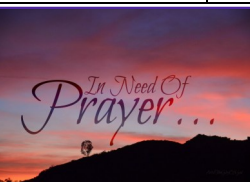

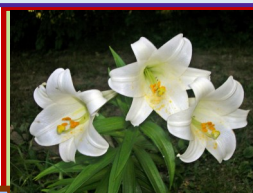


Collection Counting Update

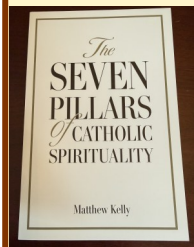

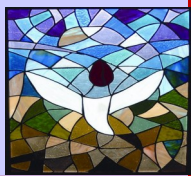
