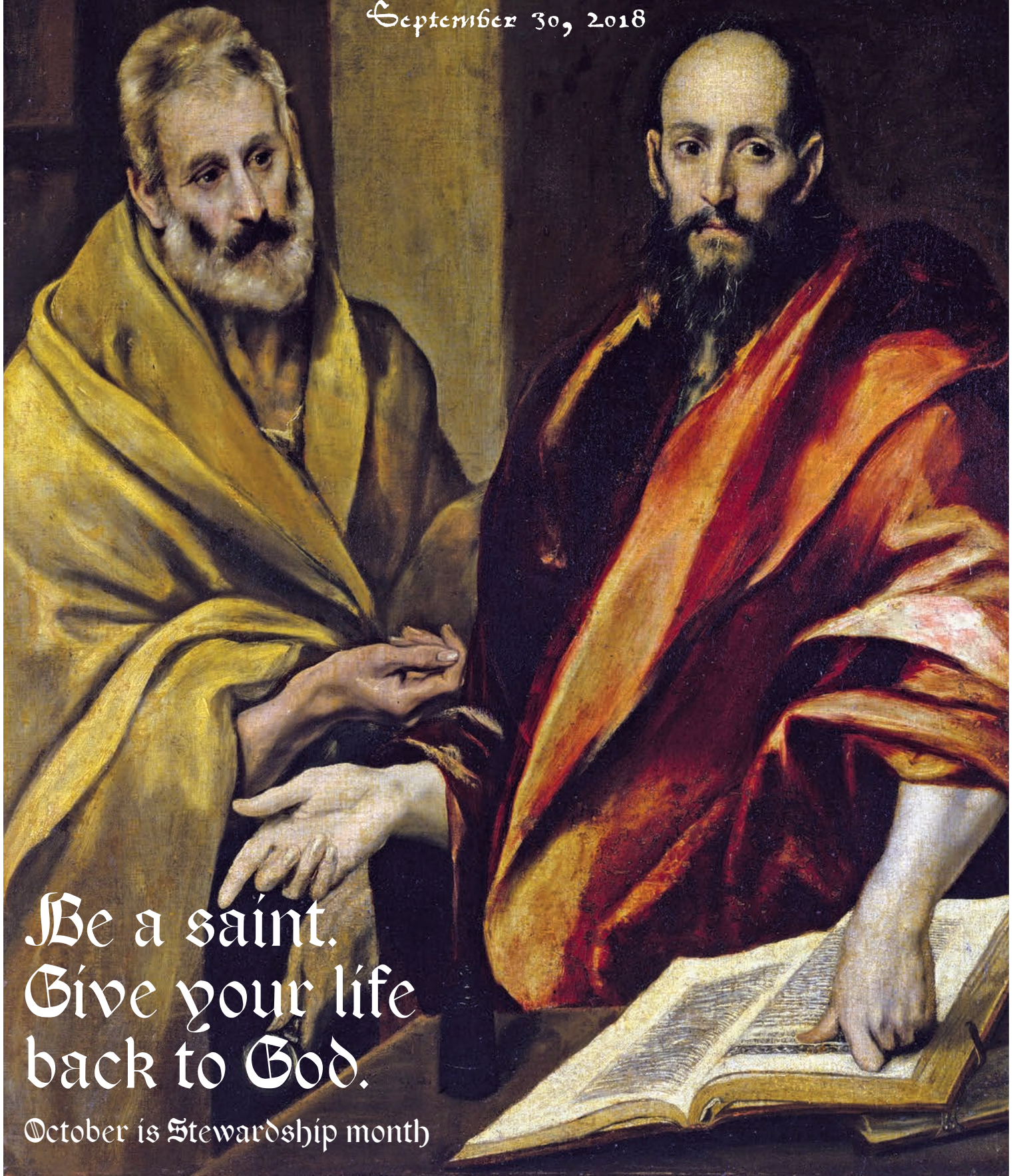

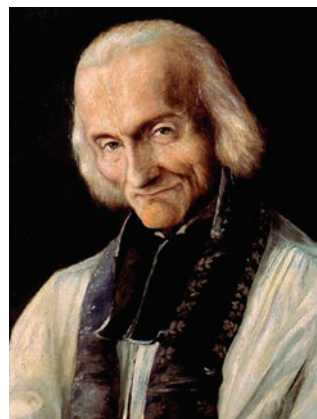

## RCIA THIS WEEK

This week's RCIA lesson is **DIVINE REVELATION: How God Reveals Himself to Humanity**

### Lives of the Saints

SAINT JEROME (342-420) was born to a wealthy pagan family, sent to Rome for his schooling and there converted to Christianity. He studied Latin, Greek, and Hebrew. He became an extraordinary scholar, considered to be the most learned of the Latin Church Fathers.

Because of his many significant theological works, most notably the thirty years he spent writing the Latin translation of the Bible (the Latin Vulgate), he is one of the most influential and orthodox theologians in the life of the early Church. In his final years he lived in a monastery that he founded in the Holy Land near Bethlehem, where he worked on writing histories and biographies in addition to drawing deeper into a life of prayer and asceticism. For his important scholarly contribution, he was named a Doctor of the Church. He is the patron of libraries, archaeologists, students, and translators.
