Catholic Schools Week

At the Catholic schools in our parish family — St. Cecilia and St. Mary — an education that is Christ centered, always with the focus of how we can improve the learning experience for each child, is provided with great care. We are constantly trying to improve the environment, the quality of instruction and the content, as well as always trying to give greater experiences outside the classroom. The goal in all that is done is to foster love of God that leads to Catholic Christian living and action. Also to inspire and motivate all of the students to truly take advantage of the great opportunity that is given to them by being able to be at a Catholic school, especially our Catholic schools that we celebrate next week.

Principals Mike Goedde and Jen Reker Murphy are leading the charge at our wonderful schools. We have dedicated teachers and staff members at the schools as well. If you know a family who is looking for a school, it would be wonderful if you could share the school information about St. Cecilia and St. Mary. Please have them call and make an appointment to visit the school or refer them to our school websites (school.stceciliacincinnati.org and www.smchp.com). **St. Cecilia had their open house on January 27, and St. Mary's open house is this Sunday, January 29, from 11:30 AM - 1 PM.**

A donation to the **Archdiocese of Cincinnati Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO)**, directing the funding to **St. Cecilia** and **St. Mary** schools, is a great opportunity to direct state funding that would otherwise be paid in taxes. There is no cost to your family individually, as the donation generates a dollar-for-dollar tax credit of \$750 per donor (up to \$1500 for a couple) to be used against Ohio tax liability. Contact your tax advisor, but in general any family with an expected tax for 2022 of \$1500 or greater can fully participate. This fund will help create additional scholarship funding for St. Cecilia and St. Mary that would otherwise be funded through the general fund. **Participate and learn more at catholicbestchoice.org/sgo/**

Please take 10 minutes to complete the survey. The results will be invaluable to me, the staff, and our many volunteers as we seek ways to best support everyone in their discipleship journey.

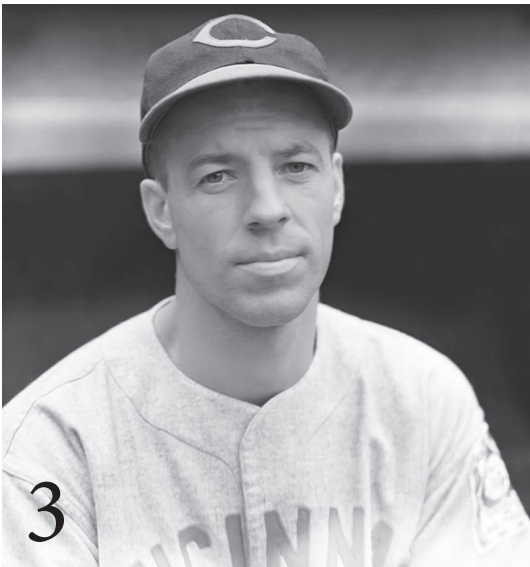

CATECHESIS (kat'i-ke'sis) n.

Lamb of God (Agnus Dei)

This is a litany prayer that accompanies the breaking of the consecrated bread at Mass. It became part of the liturgy in the West in the seventh century. Ending the last petition with “grant us peace” (*dona nobis pacem*) became common during the tenth and eleventh centuries. The reference to Jesus as the Lamb of God comes from *John 1:29*, *Revelation 5:6-13*, and other scripture passages.

KNOW YOUR SAINTS

St. Nicholas (d. ~350)

The absence of the “hard facts” of history is not necessarily an obstacle to the popularity of saints, as the devotion to St. Nicholas shows. Both the Eastern and Western Churches honor him, and it is claimed that after the Blessed Virgin, he is the saint most pictured by Christian artists. And yet, historically, we can pinpoint only the fact that Nicholas was the fourth-century bishop of Myra, a city in Lycia, a province of Asia Minor.

As with many of the saints, however, we are able to capture the relationship which Nicholas had with God through the admiration which Christians have had for him—an admiration expressed in the colorful stories which have been told and retold through the centuries.

Perhaps the best-known story about Nicholas concerns his charity toward a poor man who was unable to provide dowries for his three daughters of marriageable age. Rather than see them forced into prostitution, Nicholas secretly tossed a bag of gold through the poor man's window on three separate occasions, thus enabling the daughters to be married. Over the centuries, this particular legend evolved into the custom of gift-giving on the saint's feast. In the English-speaking countries, St. Nicholas became, by a twist of the tongue, Santa Claus—further expanding the example of generosity portrayed by this holy bishop.

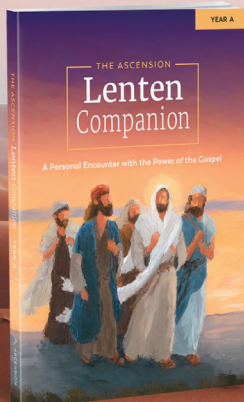
