#### **Meet Father Jones**

I grew up in Kokomo, Indiana. Yea... I'm a Hoosier. Please don't hold it against me! I attended elementary school at Sts. Joan of Arc and Patrick School. I lived in my hometown with my family until I enrolled at Franciscan University in Steuben-

ville. It was there that I made my first Buckeye friend, my roommate, Fr. Anthony Marcelli. Between my new friends at Franciscan and my drives across the state between home and college, I slowly fell in love with that promised land called Ohio!

After college and a few years of discernment, I made the decision to settle down in southwest Ohio, join the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, and apply for seminary. I attended Mt. St. Mary's Seminary in Cincinnati and was ordained a priest on May 21, 2022. 


#### Family of Faith


